

World Hunting Award Rings

DEADLINE: All record book and photo entries must be submitted by October 30 of each award year.

The SCI World Hunting Award ring, introduced in 1995, is the highest award in the World Hunting Awards program, recognizing extraordinary efforts in conservation of wildlife. A custom-crafted ring made of 18-karat gold, onyx and 40 diamonds totaling 2.5carats is presented to each recipient. To date, only 55 hunters have qualified for this prestigious award. These rings represent the premier honor in the world of hunting. Recipients are recognized at both the Trophy Records Major Awards cocktail reception and at the evening banquets during the SCI Annual Hunters' Convention. Currently, members can take 11 Grand Slams and 17 Inner Circles to be eligible for the award, including the Fourth Pinnacle of Achievement and Crowning Achievement. Effective January 1, 2008: The requirements for the World Hunting Award Ring will change to 13 SCI Grand Slams and 20 SCI Inner Circles at the Diamond Level.

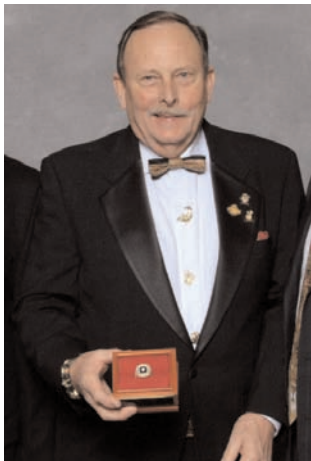
