RECORD NINE PLAYERS NAMED TO CCHA ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM

FARMINGTON HILLS, Mich. – For the first time since the award’s inception in 1988-89, nine players have been named to the Central Collegiate Hockey Association all-Academic Team. The award is voted on by the league’s faculty representatives. The six players with the most votes are selected. Ties are not broken.

Alaska Fairbanks and Michigan State each placed two members on the all-Academic team. Nebraska-Omaha senior Daniel Samuelsson is making his second straight appearance on the team while six members - Brad Fast and Adam Hall of Michigan State, Peter Michelutti of Northern Michigan, David Inman of Notre Dame, Miguel Lafleche of Ohio State and David Cousineau of Western Michigan - received honorable mention in 2000-01. Inman’s selection keeps the Irish’s streak alive at seven straight years with at least one player selected.
