ALL-CONFERENCE HISTORY FOR FERRIS STATE AND ALASKA FAIRBANKS

Michigan State goalie Ryan Miller is the lone first-team returnee

FARMINGTON HILLS, Mich. – Ferris State placed two players on the Central Collegiate Hockey Association's First-Team all-Conference squad for the first time and Alaska Fairbanks has its first all-Conference honoree while Michigan, Michigan State and Nebraska-Omaha were each honored with three all-Conference selections. The teams, which include six juniors, four seniors and two sophomores, were selected by a vote of the league's head coaches and are based on performances in league games. Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own players.

Bulldog senior forward Rob Collins, the conference scoring champion and his junior linemate Chris Kunitz, who led the conference with 25 goals, were the top vote-getters at the forward position. Nebraska-Omaha senior Jeff Hoggan, who finished tied for second in conference play with 15 goals, completes the First Team forward line. Michigan sophomore Mike Komisarek was a near-unanimous choice with 10 first-place votes for one of two defensemen's berths on the First Team. He is joined by Michigan State junior John-Michael Liles, who finished tied in voting with senior teammate Andrew Hutchinson and Nebraska-Omaha junior Greg Zanon but got the nod by virtue of having received six first-place votes. Michigan State junior goaltender Ryan Miller's second consecutive First-Team all-Conference selection continues a streak of five straight years that a Spartan netminder has been named either First- or Second-Team all-CCHA.

Senior forward Bobby Andrews is the first Nanook selected all-Conference in the seven seasons that Alaska Fairbanks has been a full-fledged member of the CCHA. He is joined by Michigan juniors Mike Cammalleri, a First Team selection last season, and John Shouneyia, giving the Wolverines two all-Conference members at the forward position on the Second Team for the first time since 1993 (David Roberts and David Oliver.) Michigan State senior Andrew Hutchinson received Second Team honors at defense for a second straight season and is paired with Nebraska-Omaha junior Greg Zanon who was a First Team honoree a year ago. Nebraska-Omaha sophomore Dan Ellis, who was a member of the all-Rookie team last season with Komisarek, is the all-Conference Second Team goalie.
