Placed tied for fourth among the CJHL's top point getters in 2001-02 and helped the Raiders capture the Yzerman Division Trophy . . . Tied the Nepean record twice for most single-game goals scored with five markers . . . Honored as the team's three-star award recipient in 2001-02 . . . Three-time (2001-02) CJHL All-Star Game participant and also competed in the 1998 CJHL Rookie All-Star Contest . . . Scored 30 goals and had 33 assists for 63 points in 2000-01 after compiling 57 points with 30 goals and 27 assists in 52 appearances for the 1999-00 campaign.

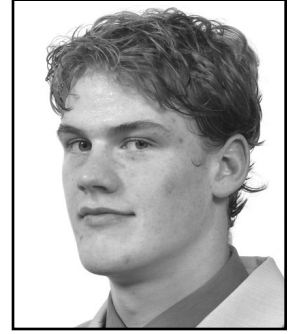
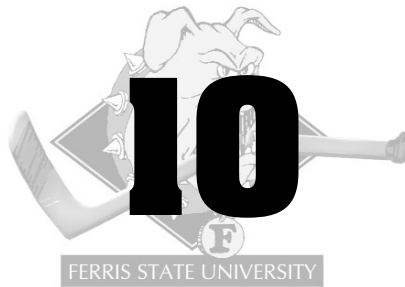

**2002-03:** A promising prospect who has a tremendous upside . . . Possesses good offensive instincts and knows how to score goals . . . Has excellent size and mobility . . . Key to amount of playing time will depend upon adjustment period to the pace of college hockey . . . Carries the puck well . . . Impressed in the preseason.

**PRIOR TO FSU:** Played for the Winnipeg (Manitoba) South Blues of Manitoba Junior Hockey League the last two seasons (2000-02) . . . Coached by Doug Stokes . . . Accumulated 65 points on 25 goals and 40 assists in 60 outings last season . . . His 65-point total was the second highest on the team and the most among the MJHL's top points leaders for defensemen . . . Placed tied for second in the MJHL for power-play goals (14) and also recorded a league-leading 442 penalty minutes a season ago . . . Selected to the MJHL All-Star Team in 2001-02 after earning a spot on the league rookie all-star team the previous campaign (2000-01) . . . Participated in the 2001-02 Viking Cup Tournament as member of the Manitoba Junior A All-Star Selects . . . Scored three goals and had three assists in seven contests at the Viking Cup Tourney, highlighted by a game-tying goal versus defending champion USA Hockey Junior Select Team and then assisted on the game-winning goal . . . Tallied four goals and had 17 assists for 21 points in 45 contests during the 2000-01 campaign . . . Spent 1999-00 with the AAA Bantam Monarchs and registered 35 points with 10 goals and 25 assists in 29 games.

**2002-03:** Heralded recruit . . . A gifted offensive player who's a pure goal scorer . . . Could develop into one of the CCHA's premier freshmen forwards if he remains healthy . . . Should receive significant ice time and figures to play considerably in power-play opportunities . . . Has a hard, accurate shot with a quick release . . . Knows his way around the net . . . Equipped with the versatility to play either at wing or center . . . Physically strong on his skates . . . Signed with FSU during last November's early signing period.

**PRIOR TO FSU:** Honored as the 2001-02 USA Hockey Junior Player-of-the-Year as a member of the Springfield (Ill.) Jr. Blues . . . Spent two seasons (2000-02) with the Blues of the North American Hockey League, earning NAHL's First-Team accolades in 2001-02 . . . Coached by Nick Pollos and Chris Wyler . . . Posted a team-high 40 goals with 29 assists for a team-best 69 points in 52 games to pace team in scoring for the second straight year . . . His 40 goals was third best in the NAHL and his 69 points ranked sixth highest . . . Played for Team USA Junior Selects in 2001-02 Viking Cup and was only U.S. Player to gain all-star first-team recognition after tying for top team scoring honors (5-2-7) . . . Achieved both NAHL Rookie-of-the-Year and second-team all-league honors in 2000-01 after totaling 68 points (43-25-68) in 53 outings . . . Member of 2000-01 NAHL All-Rookie Team . . . Helped the Chicago Flames to the 1999-00 Midget AA National Championship with 137 points (79-58-137) in 60 games.

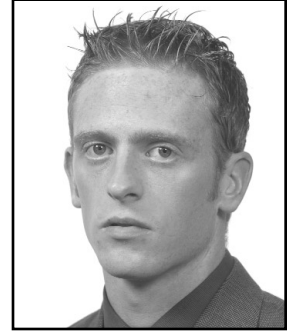
