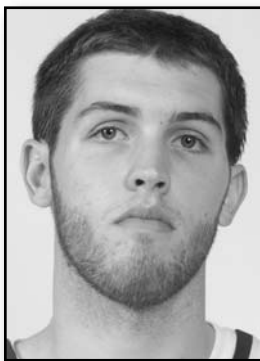


MEET THE 2008-09 BULLDOGS

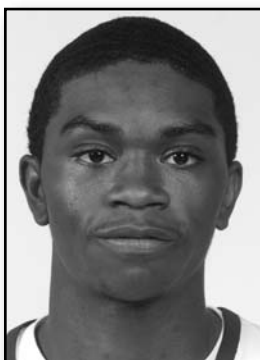

High School: A 2008 graduate of Detroit Pershing High School ... Capped off prep career by leading Detroit Pershing to a MHSAA Class A State Runner-up finish in 2008 ... Earned Detroit News Class A Honorable Mention All-State accolades twice ... Prepped by head coach A.W. Canada ... Two-time All-Detroit Public School League (PSL) selection ... Helped the Doughboys to a 22-5 overall record as a senior ... Tallied seven steals, six points and four assists in 29 minutes as Pershing topped Romulus 79-77 in overtime in the state semifinals (3/14/08) at Michigan State's Breslin Center in East Lansing ... Led squad to district and regional titles his final season ... Four-year letterwinner ... Averaged 16 points, six assists, four rebounds and three steals per contest in 2007-08 ... Netted 12 points, four assists, three boards and two thefts a game his junior team ... Team captain ... Helped Pershing to three district crowns and a city runner-up finish during his prep career ... All-Metro and All-PSL East standout ... Ranked by Inside Prep Sports as the state's number six point guard in the class of 2008 ... Also competed in cross country.

2008-09: Good outside shooter ... Has significant playing experience at the Division II level ... Coming off an outstanding season at North Greenville ... Worked hard over the summer ... Expected to play a significant role.

College: Transferred to FSU from NCAA-II member North Greenville in Tigerville, S.C. ... Averaged a team-high 20.7 points while starting all 27 contests for the Crusaders in 2007-08 ... Sank 83 of 197 (.421) three-point attempts and shot 78.9% (105-133) at the free throw stripe ... Also averaged 5.6 rebounds a game as North Greenville compiled a 7-20 overall record ... Was the team's leading scorer in all but five games last season ... Scored 30 points or more in four outings ... Reached double-figures in all but three games in the 2007-08 season ... Tallied 11.1 points and 3.4 rebounds per contest while helping the squad to a 16-13 overall record under head coach Chad Lister in 2006-07 ... ICAA Player of the Year Runner-Up in 2007-08 ... First-Team All-Conference pick.

High School: A 2006 graduate of McBain High School ... Averaged 24 points and seven rebounds per game as a prep senior in 2005-06 ... Led the Ramblers to a 21-3 overall record and a district championship ... Garnered all-state, all-region, all-conference and all-area awards as both a junior and a senior ... Team MVP ... Posted school records for points in a season ... Coached by Bruce Koopman ... Also competed in golf, baseball and track.
