2008-09: *Expected to redshirt this season ... Will have one year of eligibility left at FSU ... Asked to step into a leadership role ... Should be a valuable part of the team's preparation this season ... Has good experience and skills ... Strong player.*

College: Played for NCAA Division I Central Michigan during both the 2005-06 and 2007-08 campaigns ... Appeared in all 28 games and made two starts as a freshman in 2005-06, but did not see game action last season ... Averaged 2.3 points and 1.2 rebounds in his initial season with the Chippewas, including two double-figure scoring efforts ... Also competed at Schoolcraft Community College the year between his two CMU stints (2006-07) and totaled 13.1 points along with 7.9 rebounds per contest in 27 games.

High School: Graduated from Thornapple-Kellogg High School ... Was an all-conference and all-area honoree ... Earned third team Class B All-State honors ... Grand Rapids Press All-Area selection ... Ranked number 21 in the state by the *Detroit Free Press* as a senior ... Was ranked 12th in the state by *PrepSpotlight.com* ... Played in the BCAM All-Star Game ... Three-time all-conference pick ... Averaged 19.5 points, 5.8 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game as a senior ... Coached by Kurt Holzhueter.

College: Played at Kellogg Community College in Battle Creek the last two seasons ... Was a second team All-Michigan Community College Athletic Association (MCCAA) Western Conference pick for the Bruins in 2006-07 ... Helped Kellogg CC to the MCCAA Western Conference Championship in 2006-07 as team posted a 25-7 record and was 13-1 in league play ... Played under head coach Clint Stout while at Kellogg CC ... Helped team to both a regional runner-up finish and a conference championship during his JUCO career ... One of four Kellogg CC players from the 2007-08 season who moved on to play at a four-year institution ... Helped squad to a 16-12 overall record his final season, including a fourth-place (9-7) finish in the MCCAA Western Conference ... Squad advanced to postseason tourney both seasons.

High School: Prepped at Ypsilanti High School ... Earned *Detroit News* Class A Sixth Team all-state accolades in 2005 ... Led the Braves in scoring and was both an all-conference and all-area honoree ... Averaged in double-figures his final three seasons.

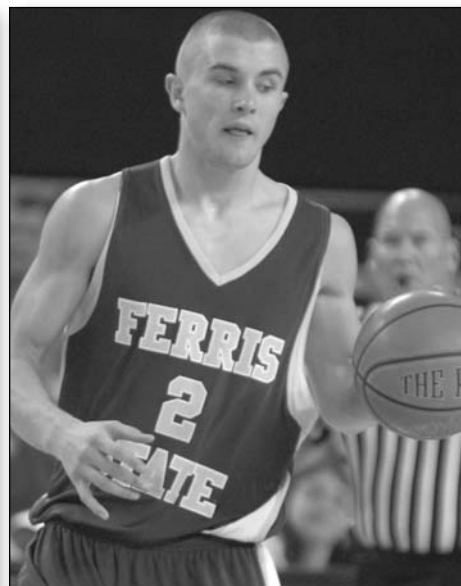
