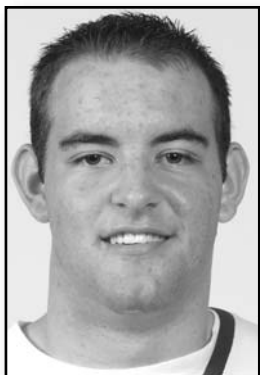


MEET THE 2008-09 BULLDOGS

2008-09: Had a good preseason ... Tremendous shooter with good range ... Likely to see playing time this year ... Continues to develop overall quickness and athleticism needed at collegiate level ... Works hard.

College: 2007-08: Played in 20 games and made one start ... Scored in double-figures three times, including his first two games of the year ... Had 19 points and sank six three-point field goals against Grace Bible (11/9) ... Totaled 15 points in season opener vs. Hillsdale (11/17) ... Also had 14 points at Lake Superior State (12/15) ... Made 24 three-point field goals on the year and shot 36.4% beyond the arc ... Played 192 total minutes ... Scored in 10 different contests ... Finished with 12 assists and five steals as a reserve ... Tallied seven points in his lone start of the year at St. Joseph's (12/17) ... Netted six points at Northwood (12/1).

High School: A 2007 graduate of Greenville High School ... Averaged 11 points and five rebounds per game as a prep senior ... Helped team to a 13-10 overall record ... First-team all-area selection ... Chosen as squad's Most Improved Player ... Shot 43% from behind the three-point line in final campaign ... Totaled six points and two rebounds per contest as a junior ... Guided team to two-straight district runner-up finishes ... Hit a game-winning fade away three-pointer against Wyoming Park with only 0.7 seconds left to play in prep career ... Coached by Mark Haist ... Two-year letterwinner ... Also competed in baseball as a prep student-athlete.

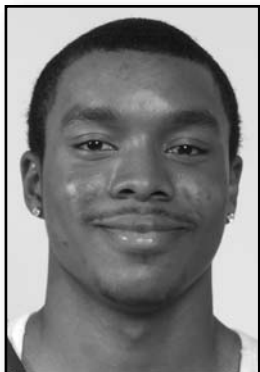

2008-09: Returning starter ... Displays tremendous quickness ... One of squad's best defenders on the ball ... Made strides during his freshman season ... Battling for time at the point guard position ... Has displayed lots of great tools to become quality player.

College: 2007-08: Started 24 of 29 games ... Led team with 99 assists and was second with 27 steals ... Reached double-figures in seven games with a season-high 17 vs. Michigan Tech (2/9) ... Had 15 points against Wayne State (1/9) ... Placed third on team with 25 made three-pointers and shot 34.7% from three-point range ... Averaged 6.8 points, 3.4 assists and 2.4 rebounds a contest ... Sank game-winning jumper in closing seconds to beat Saginaw Valley State (11/29) ... Scored three points in his collegiate debut against Hillsdale (11/17) ... Tallied 12 points at Alma (11/21) ... Totaled four assists or more in 13 different contests ... Twice had seven assists in a game ... Made four three-pointers with seven assists and two blocked shots at Ashland (1/31).

High School: A 2007 graduate of Detroit Henry Ford High School ... Helped team to a 15-7 overall mark in 2006-07 as the squad advanced to the regional final before falling to Detroit Osborn his senior campaign ... Directed Detroit Henry Ford's attack from the point guard position ... Earned *Detroit Free Press* All-Detroit Honorable Mention honors as a prep senior ... Averaged 15 points per game his final campaign ... Tallied 19 points a contest as a sophomore along with 18 points per game his freshman year ... Chosen as team's Most Valuable Player Award recipient ... All-Conference selection ... Earned All-City honors three consecutive years ... Played in the competitive Detroit Public School League (PSL) ... Coached by Arvis Young ... Prep teammate of former FSU guard/forward DeJuan Wright.
