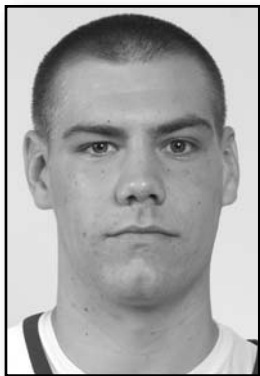

**College: 2007-08:** Started three of first four games ...

Appeared in 26 outings ... Received team's Sixth Player Award ... Totaled career-high nine points in season opener vs. Hillsdale (11/17) ... Finished with 45 points, 39 rebounds, 11 assists and 11 steals ... GLIAC All-Academic Team honoree ... Scored in 13 different contests ... Sank career-high six three-pointers on the year ... **2006-07:** Played in 16 contests as a reserve ... Grabbed 11 rebounds and had eight points ... Named to GLIAC All-Academic Team ... Earned team Coaches Award ... Had season-high four points and three boards at Gannon (1/20) ... Scored two points at rival Grand Valley State in GLIAC Tourney (2/27) ... Also scored a single point and had one rebound at Ashland (1/26) ... Made only field goal attempt of the year and was one-of-two (.500) in free throws ... Valuable reserve on NCAA-II Tourney Team.

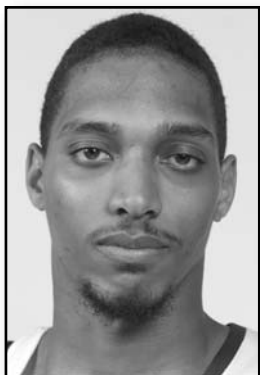

**2008-09:** Good all-around athlete ... Becoming more of a leader ... Has displayed ability to be an effective rebounder ... Solid finisher inside ... Continues to progress ... Integral part of team unit ... Will be asked to step up level of play again this year.

**College: 2007-08:** Appeared in all 29 games and made 13 starts ... Scored 146 points and pulled down 114 rebounds ... Shot 49.6% from the floor ... Was team's fourth-leading rebounder for the campaign and ranked second in field goal percentage ... Scored in double-digits twice with 14 points vs. Tiffin (1/5) and 10 points vs. Wayne State (1/9) in back-to-back home games ... Also tallied career-high nine rebounds, blocked five shots and dished out three assists against Wayne State ... Sank 14-of-21 (.667) free throws ...

**2006-07:** Played in all 28 games and started one contest ... Scored 95 points and had 56 rebounds ... Tallied season-high 10 points vs. Northwood (2/3) ... Grabbed six rebounds vs. Michigan Tech (2/8) ... Shot a squad-best 60.3% (41-68) from the field ... Recorded eight points in six games ... Scored in 18 of his 28 appearances ... Played 370 total minutes ... Pulled down five rebounds in three contests ... Averaged 3.4 points and 2.0 rebounds a game ... Also had 16 steals, 10 assists and nine blocked shots on the year ... Made 13-of-17 (.765) free throw attempts ... Saw a season-best 22 minutes of playing time in GLIAC road victory at Lake Superior State (2/17) ... **Prior to Ferris State:** Played in six games for NCAA Division I Cleveland State in 2005-06 ... Sat out the 2004-05 season at Cleveland State to meet NCAA initial eligibility requirements ... Scored three points and grabbed three rebounds in 16 minutes of action.

**High School:** A 2004 graduate of Saginaw Arthur Hill High School ... Three-year starter ... Coached by Greg McMath ... Helped team set school-record for wins with a 22-2 record as a senior ... Squad was ranked as top team in state ... Ranked as number seven wing player in the state by *MichiganPreps.Com* ... Four-time honorable mention all-league honoree ... Also played AAU basketball for the Michigan Hurricanes and Team Michigan ... Lettered in track as both a freshman and sophomore ... Ran in the 4x400-meter relay and competed in the high jump.
