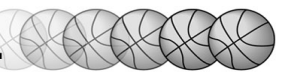


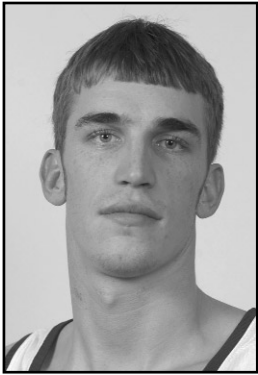

Coach Wilson on Anderson: "Adam has assumed the leadership position on this team and has strengthened his commitment both on and off the floor to a point where he could be a dominant force in this league."

College: 2000-01: Led the GLIAC in scoring at 21.3 points per game ... Scored 555 points and had 173 rebounds ... Was a first-team All-Great Lakes Region and All-GLIAC North Division pick ... Honored as FSU's Most Valuable Player ... Made the GLIAC All-Defensive Team ... Scored a career-high 31 points against Northern Michigan (2/3) ... Posted two double-doubles ... Recorded his 1,000th career point against Northwood (2/10) ... Set a FSU single-season record with 50 rejections in becoming the all-time Bulldog career leader ... Notched the most free throws in a single-season (179) in school history ... Was the GLIAC Player of the Week (2/19) ... Tied a single-game FSU record with seven blocked shots at Grand Valley State (1/22) ... Reached double-figures in scoring in all 26 games ... **1999-00:** Started all 26 games ... Was a second-team All-GLIAC selection after ranking among the conference leaders in blocks and field goal percentage ... Averaged 14.6 points and 7.0 rebounds per game ... Scored 25 points at Saginaw Valley State (2/26) ... Had seven double-double performances ... Grabbed a career-high 13 boards at Findlay (11/20) ... Scored 15.3 points per game in conference action ... **1998-99:** Finished second on the team and recorded the ninth-best single-season block total (21) in Bulldog history ... Was tied for third on the squad in rebounding (3.6 rpg) and tied for fourth in scoring (6.8 ppg) ... Reached double figures in points six times, including a career-best 20 at Lake Superior State (1/16).

High School: 1998 graduate of Kent City High School ... Finished fifth in Michigan's Mr. Basketball voting ... Was a McDonald's All-America candidate ... Averaged 23.1 points, 15.3 rebounds and 5.5 blocks per game while helping the Eagles to league and district championships as a senior ... Was a first-team all-state selection with *The Associated Press*, *Detroit News* and *Detroit Free Press* ... Selected to the *Grand Rapids Press* Class C Dream Team ... Two-time All-Newaygo County Athletic Association and *Muskegon Chronicle* all-area honoree ... Finished his prep career with 1,093 points ... Coached by Roger Bearup ... Played in the Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan All-Star Game.

Personal: Son of John and Sally Anderson ... Born 3/27/79 in Grand Rapids, Mich. ... Brother Cory played basketball at Ferris for two years (1996-98) and is currently an assistant coach ... Played basketball in England with a U.S. all-star team in May 1997 ... Majoring in heavy equipment technology.

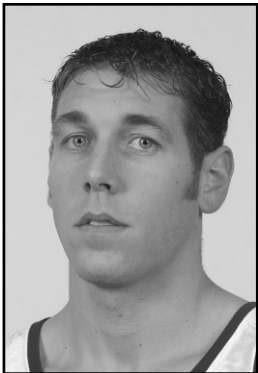

Coach Wilson on Miller: "I've been extremely pleased with his maturity and leadership abilities. He is the vocal leader on our team and is playing with confidence."

College: 2000-01: Played in 25 games ... Scored a season-high 12 points against Grand Valley State (2/12) ... Reached double-figures in scoring three times ... Had 103 points and 53 rebounds ... Scored six points in his only start against Lake Superior State (12/7) ... Tallied 11 points and six rebounds in a win over Northwood (12/9) ... Totaled 11 points at Southern Indiana (12/29) ... Received a Captain's Award for team leadership ... **1999-00:** Saw action in 19 games ... Started 12 contests and played 303 total minutes ... Scored a career-high 11 points in final contest of the season at Saginaw Valley State (2/26) ... Had 10 points on a 5-of-5 shooting performance against Calvin (11/30) ... Grabbed a career-high nine rebounds at Quincy (11/27) ... Scored 54 points and had 55 rebounds in GLIAC contests ... Was 3-of-3 from the floor at Grand Valley State (2/14) ... Made 5-of-6 free throws at Saginaw Valley State (2/26) ... Scored in all but three games ... Had a rebound in all but one contest ... **1998-99:** Finished tied for the team lead in field goal percentage (.492, 31-63) and shot 51.9 percent (28-54) in 19 GLIAC games ... Grabbed a career-best seven rebounds vs. Hillsdale (11/21) ... Made 5-of-7 field goals for a career-best 10 points at Mercyhurst (1/9) ... Started five of the season's final six games and shot 54.2 percent (13-24) from the floor during that span.

High School: 1998 graduate of Bridgman High School ... Was a *Detroit News* third team all-state honoree ... Averaged 20.0 points, 15.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game while helping the Bees to a 17-2 record as a senior ... Received first team All-Red Arrow Conference honors in 1998 ... Selected as a team captain and named Bridgman's Most Valuable Player his final season ... Coached by Mike Miller ... Earned varsity letters in basketball (3), baseball (2) and soccer (2).
