

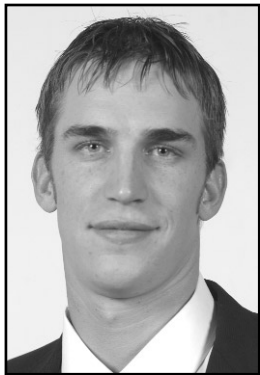

College: 2002-03: Ferris' primary option under the basket ... Continues to expand offensive game ... Will be relied upon to increase rebounding role ... Excellent shot blocker ... 2001-02: Missed the final 23 games due to a bone bruise injury (knee) suffered in a 79-59 non-conference home win versus Olivet (11/20) ... Granted an extra season of eligibility through the NCAA's medical redshirt process ... 2000-01: Led the GLIAC in scoring at 21.3 points per game ... Scored 555 points and had 173 rebounds ... Was a first-team All-Great Lakes Region, GLIAC All-Defensive Team and All-GLIAC North Division pick ... FSU's Most Valuable Player ... Scored a career-high 31 points vs. Northern Michigan (2/3) ... Posted two double-doubles ... Recorded his 1,000th career point vs. Northwood (2/10) ... Set FSU single-season and career records with 50 blocked shots ... Notched the school's single-season made free throw mark (179) ... GLIAC Player of the Week (2/19) ... Tied FSU's single-game blocked shots (7) record at Grand Valley State (1/22) ... Totaled 26 double-figure scoring games ... 1999-00: Started all 26 games ... Second-team All-GLIAC selection ... Ranked among the GLIAC's leaders in blocks and field goal percentage ... Averaged 14.6 points and 7.0 rebounds per game ... Scored 25 points at Saginaw Valley State (2/26) ... Had seven double-double performances ... Scored 15.3 points per game in league action ... 1998-99: Recorded the school's ninth-best single-season block total (21) ... Was tied for third on the squad in rebounding (3.6 rpg) and tied for fourth in scoring (6.8 ppg) ... Reached double figures in points six times, including 20 at Lake Superior State (1/16).
High School: 1998 graduate of Kent City High School ... Finished fifth in Michigan's Mr. Basketball voting ... Was a McDonald's All-America candidate ... Averaged 23.1 points, 15.3 rebounds and 5.5 blocks per game while helping the Eagles to league and district championships ... Was a first-team *Associated Press*, *Detroit News* and *Detroit Free Press* all-state selection ... Named to the *Grand Rapids Press* Class C Dream Team ... Two-time All-Newaygo County Athletic Association and *Muskegon Chronicle* all-area honoree ... Finished prep career with 1,093 points ... Coached by Roger Bearup ... Played in the Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan All-Star Game.
Personal: Son of John and Sally Anderson of Kent City, Mich. ... Born 3/27/79 in Grand Rapids, Mich. ... Brother Cory played basketball at Ferris for two years (1996-98) and is currently an assistant coach ... Played basketball in England with a U.S. all-star team in May 1997 ... Majoring in heavy equipment technology.

Continues to work on developing consistent jump shot and defensive skills ... 2001-02: Appeared in 25 games while making three starts ... Averaged 3.5 points and 1.6 rebounds per game ... Tallied 23 assists and 11 steals ... Scored a career-best nine points at Northern Michigan (2/3) ... Added eight points and three rebounds in nine minutes of action at Grand Valley State (2/11) ... Had five points, three steals and three rebounds in Ferris' league opener at Findlay (11/29) ... Totaled seven points and three rebounds vs. Mercyhurst (12/8) ... Registered at least one point in 21 outings.
High School: A 2001 graduate of Royal Oak Shrine High School ... Averaged 21.5 points per game as a senior (2000-01) ... Led the Knights in rebounding (10.0 rpg) and assists (4.0 apg) ...
