**Muskegon Heights, Mich. (Muskegon CC)**

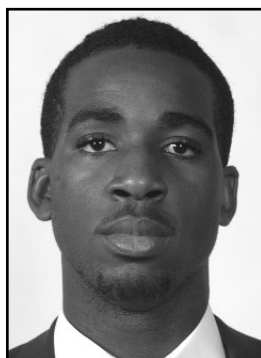
**2003-04:** Will play both the wing and power forward spots ... Has significant experience after playing junior college basketball ... Improving from a defensive standpoint.

### MICHAEL DANIELS



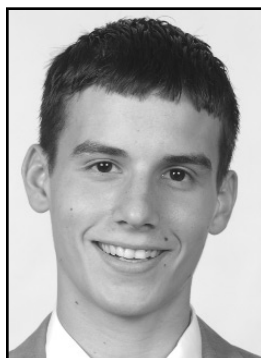
**6-6 ♦ 210 ♦ Freshman ♦ Forward**

### JOE DEMARTIN



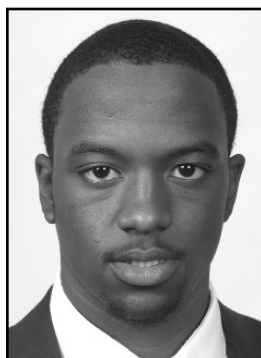
**6-1 ♦ 160 ♦ Freshman ♦ Guard**
