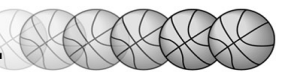

College: 2003-04: One of team's top outside shooters ... Intelligent basketball player ... Expected to provide spot duty off the bench ... Has progressed well ... 2002-03: Played in 11 contests ... Scored a season-high six points in nine minutes of action at Olivet (12/14) ... Appeared in seven league games ... Tallied five points at Grand Valley State (1/18) ... Scored three points and grabbed two rebounds in season finale at Michigan Tech (2/22) ... Registered two points vs. Lake Superior State (2/6) ... Dished out two assists in his initial appearance vs. Calvin (11/26) ... Placed fourth among team leaders in three-point field goal percentage (.364) ... Sank his only two free throw attempts vs. Lake Superior State (2/6) ... 2000-02: Played collegiate basketball at Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference member Siena Heights for two seasons (2000-02) ... Totaled 16.8 points and 2.5 assists per game in junior varsity action in 2001-02 after redshirting his initial season.

High School: A 2000 graduate of Harbor Springs High School ... Was a four-year letterwinner in basketball and earned three in soccer ... Averaged 28.7 points and four assists per game while leading Harbor Springs to a 16-5 overall record in his senior campaign ... Tied state single-game three-point field goal record with 11 treys ... Scored 22 points per game as a junior ... Was a three-time all-conference pick and two-time team MVP selection ... Served as team captain ... Earned third-team all-state accolades ... Once scored 50 points in a single game ... Prepped by Geoff Morse.

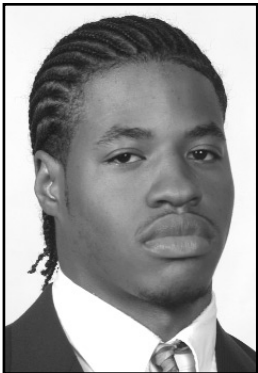

College: 2003-04: Regarded as one of squad's top defensive players ... Versatile athlete ... Will be asked to be a go-to-guy on the offensive end ... 2002-03: Started all 26 games ... Received team Defensive MVP Award accolades ... Placed third among team's scoring leaders (11.6 ppg) and had a team-high 51 steals ... Notched 112 rebounds and sank 44 three-point baskets ... Ranked fourth in steals (1.96 spg) among league leaders ... Tallied 23 points at Northern Michigan (2/20) ... Totaled 17 double-figure scoring contests ... Led team in steals nine times ... Grabbed 12 boards vs. Hillsdale (1/2) ... Poured in 20 points at Lake Superior State (1/25) ... 2001-02: Started 22 contests ... Was the squad's second-leading rebounder (5.0 rpg) ... Averaged 9.5 points and 2.2 assists per game ... Tallied Ferris' eighth-best (58) all-time single-season steals mark ... Ranked third among the GLIAC's steals leaders (2.42 spg) and seventh (2.46 rpg) in the league's offensive rebound category ... Attained a personal career-high 27 points while making 10 of 15 attempts vs. Aquinas (11/27) ... Scored in double-figures 11 times ... Had three double-double (points and rebounds) performances, including 21 points and 10 rebounds at Calvin (12/1) ... Netted a team-high 20 points at Grand Valley State (2/11) ... Totaled 13 points, 11 rebounds, six assists and five steals in FSU's win (12/27) at Grand Canyon (Ariz.) ... Grabbed 10 rebounds and had 11 points against Gannon (12/6) ... Made 10 consecutive free throws in back-to-back road games (11/29-12/1) at Findlay and Calvin.

High School: A 2001 graduate of Benton Harbor High School ... Was the team's top three-point shooter as a senior (2000-01) ... Ranked among the team's leading scorers (15.2 ppg) ... Led Benton Harbor to a 25-1 mark and a berth in the Class A state quarterfinals ... Also was a member of the varsity cross country and baseball teams ... Earned varsity letters in basketball, baseball and cross country ... Prepped by Paul Wilhite ... Helped the Tigers win the Big Eight Conference title, the district championship and the regional title ... Earned the Tiger Sixth Man Award as a junior.

Personal: Son of Nanci Epps of Benton Harbor, Mich. ... Born 7/17/83 in St. Joseph, Mich. ... Was a three-year National Honor Society member ... Took part in the human relations club ... Mother works as a teacher's assistant ... Majoring in computer information systems ... Enjoys drawing and playing video games ... Twin brother of FSU teammate Corey Epps ...
