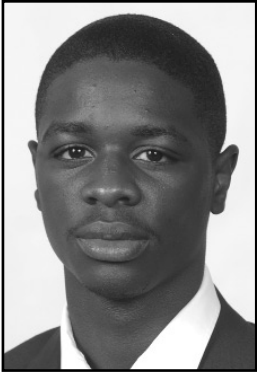


MEET THE 2003-04 BULLDOGS

College: 2003-04: Played well as a freshman ... Expected to develop leadership skills and be the team's quarterback as a point guard ... Improved his outside shooting touch ... Has considerable quickness ... **2002-03:** Started all 26 contests ... Totaled 155 assists, which represented the fourth-highest single-season figure in school history ... Led team in assists (6.0 apg), was second in steals (1.9 spg) and fourth in scoring (11.3 ppg) ... Played a team-high 864 minutes ... Was GLIAC's assists leader, ranked third in assist/turnover ratio (1.96) and finished sixth in steals (1.9 spg) ... Registered a triple-double performance with 16 points, 13 assists and 10 steals vs. Calvin (11/26) ... Scored a personal career-high 22 points and had six rebounds while shooting 10-of-13 (.769) from the floor at Olivet (12/14) ... Tallied 20 points at Lake Superior State (1/25) ... Recorded 15 double-figure scoring performances ... Led team in assists 19 times and in steals on 10 occasions ... Notched 10 assists or more in five outings ... Totaled 14 points, 10 assists and six rebounds vs. Lake Superior State (2/6) ... Had 13 points and five assists in collegiate debut at Saint Joseph's (11/22) ... Netted 18 points and 10 assists at Aquinas (12/3) ... Sank four three-point baskets en route to a 17-point performance at Hillsdale (12/27) ... Averaged nine assists per game in 10 home appearances ... Ranked 19th nationally in assists per game (6.0 apg) ... **2001-02:** Attended Bowling Green State during the 2001-02 academic year, but did not play collegiate basketball.

High School: A 2001 graduate of Scott High School in Toledo, Ohio ... Received third-team 2000-01 Ohio High School Athletic Association Division I All-State accolades ... Averaged 15.5 points per game as a senior while leading the Bulldogs to a conference title, district championship and regional runner-up finish during his prep career ... Was a two-time (2000-01) All-Toledo City League selection ... Named the *Toledo Blade's* 2001 Player of the Year ... Earned conference all-academic honors in 2000-01 ... Selected as the 2000-01 OHSAA District Player of the Year ... Prepped by Earl Morris.

Personal: Son of Dennis and Jackie Springs of Toledo, Ohio ... Born 10/22/82 in Toledo, Ohio ... Majoring in social studies ... Participated in Bowling Green State's Upward Bound college preparation program ... Father is employed by Ford Motor Company while his mother is a public school driver.

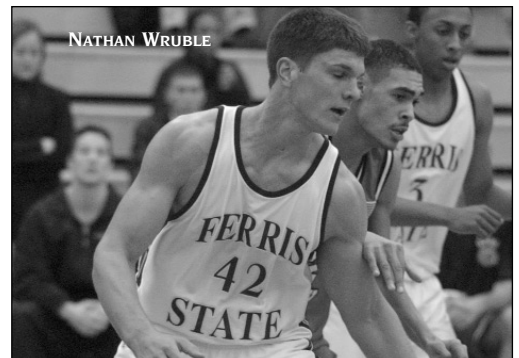
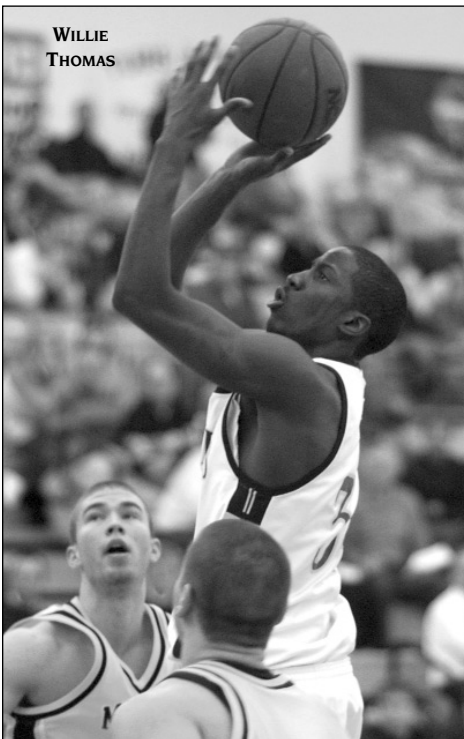
