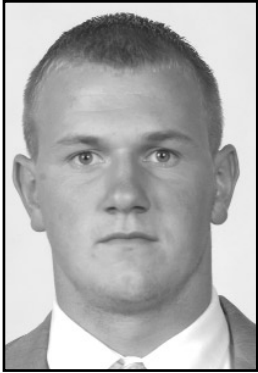

College: 2004-05: Has shown vast improvement ... Expected to contribute more this season ... Continues to adjust to collegiate game ... Versatile two-sport athlete ... Tremendous competitor ... 2003-04: Appeared in 20 contests ... Compiled 46 points, 15 rebounds and 11 assists ... Scored nine points and sank four-of-six (66.7%) field goal attempts at Hillsdale (1/15) ... Totaled nine points and five rebounds versus Glenville State, W.Va. (12/30) ... Netted five points at Grand Valley State (2/16) ... Recorded five points and two steals versus Indianapolis (12/19) ... Tallied two points and one rebound in his collegiate debut versus Lake Superior State (12/11) ... Notched two points along with both one rebound and assist as FSU claimed the GLIAC North Division Championship with a victory over Michigan Tech (2/28) ... Led team in field goal percentage by making 18-of-37 (48.6%) of season field goal attempts.

High School: A 2003 graduate of West Ottawa High School ... Totaled 22 points and 11 rebounds per game in 2002-03 ... Led WOHS to a school-record 15-7 overall record and a MHSAA Class A district semifinal finish ... Team Captain ... Garnered 2002-03 *Detroit Free Press* Class A Sixth-Team All-State and *Associated Press* Class A Honorable Mention All-State kudos ... Was a third-team 2002-03 *Grand Rapids Press* All-Area Dream Teamer ... Twice (2002-03) attained first-team All-Ottawa-Kent (OK) Red Conference recognition and was a *Holland Sentinel* All-Area pick ... Coached by Von Washington ... Also was a three-time all-conference quarterback ... Threw for 2,139 yards and 29 touchdowns in senior year to rank 20th all-time among state single-season passing leaders and sixth in TD's ... Guided Panthers to most wins in school history (8-3) and first-ever football playoff victory in 2002 ... First-Team 2002 Class A All-State football honoree ... Two-year varsity baseball letterwinner.

Personal: Son of James and Diane Van Wieren of Holland, Mich. ... Born 2/27/85 in Holland, Mich. ... Also playing football at Ferris State ... Played on special teams and was a backup quarterback as a redshirt freshman during the 2004 season ... Earned West Ottawa's Scholar-Athlete Award ... Majoring in social studies ... 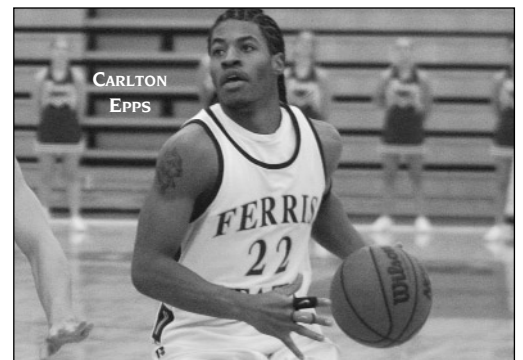
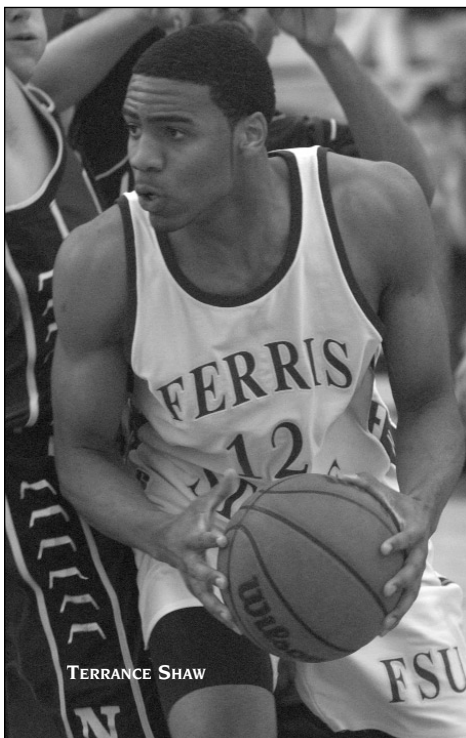
