2004-05: *Has good size and wing span ... Must develop interior post game ... Continues to improve overall strength ... Adapting to style of play ... Should provide added depth and size.*

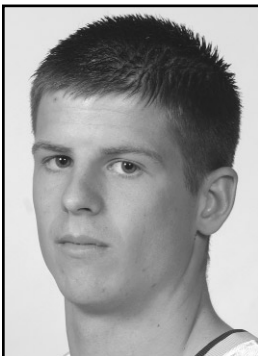
College: Redshirted during the 2003-04 campaign.

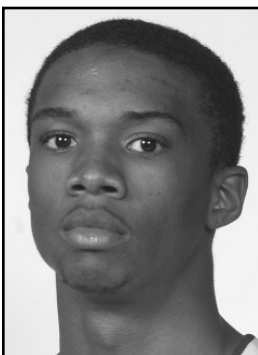

Averaged 25.4 points, seven assists and four rebounds per game while leading CSHS to a 22-1 overall record and a district crown as a senior ... Attained first-team 2003-04 Class B All-State recognition from the Associated Press, Detroit News and Michiganpreps.com along with Grand Rapids Press All-Area Dream Team accolades ... Led CSHS to the school's first-ever unbeaten regular season and second-straight district title in 2003-04 ... Squad was ranked fourth in state ... Reached regional semifinals in senior campaign ... Three-time All-Ottawa Kent (OK) Gold and White Team honoree ... Helped the Red Hawks win their first conference title (OK White) since 1977 ... Prepped by current FSU volunteer assistant coach Dave Schlump ... Became third player in school history to register 1,000 career points ... Three-year varsity starter ... Attained 2002-03 Detroit Free Press Class B Fifth Team All-State recognition ... Led CSHS to an 18-7 overall mark and a regional finals appearance in 2002-03.

Guided MHHS to a 25-2 overall mark as a senior ... Claimed 2003-04 Muskegon Chronicle All-Area Dream Team kudos ... Led team to Class B State Semifinals in 2003-04 after winning regional title at FSU's Jim Wink Arena for second-straight season ... Averaged 18.6 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.6 steals per game in his final campaign ... Helped Muskegon Heights capture both its third consecutive district and regional title under first-year head coach and former Ferris State men's basketball player Keith Guy (1995-97) ... Selected to play in the annual Ta-Wa-Si high school benefit all-star boys basketball game ... Totaled 46 made three-pointers as a senior ... Sparked the Tigers to a 21-4 record under current Central Michigan University Assistant Coach Lamar Chapman in 2002-03 while earning MHSAA Class B State Runner-Up plaudits ... Received third-team Detroit Free Press Class B All-State kudos in his junior campaign.
