The Ferris State men's basketball program played its home games at Old Jim Wink Arena in the Health and Physical Education Building from 1963-98. The Bulldogs compiled an impressive 304-89 (.707) record on the court and won 10 or more home games in a season 15 times.

FORMER BULLDOG APPEARS ON SCREEN

Former FSU men's basketball player Jeff Hephner (1996-99) landed an acting role in the Fox Television courtroom drama series, "The Jury", which debuted during the 2004 summer programming season.

Hephner, whose recent film credits have included "Tigerland" (2000), "The Outlands" (2002) and "Maid in Manhattan" (2002), played assistant district attorney Keenan O'Brien prior to the series' cancellation.

The 6-3 Hephner appeared in 42 games during his three-year Bulldog playing career. He served as the squad's team captain during the 1998-99 campaign and totaled 58 points along with 27 rebounds as an FSU player. The Sand Creek High School product previously played two seasons at Calvin College before transferring to Ferris State. Hephner, who red-shirted during the 1996-97 campaign, was a member of the Bulldogs' 1997-98 Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Tournament championship team which posted a 21-12 overall record and a fourth-place (10-8) GLIAC North Division finish.

A college roommate and former teammate of current FSU assistant men's basketball coach Cory Anderson, Hephner presently resides in New York City. FSU head coach Bill Sall served as a Bulldog assistant coach during Hephner's initial two seasons at Ferris State.
