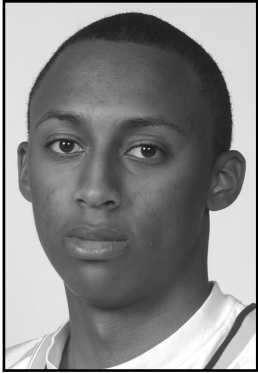


## MEET THE 2004-05 BULLDOGS

**College:** **2004-05:** Energetic ... Versatile athlete ... Will provide spot duty ... **2003-04:** Did not play collegiate basketball ... **2002-03:** Played in 15 contests ... Totaled 17 points, eight assists and five rebounds ... Scored a season-high three points at Hillsdale (12/27) ... Netted three points and two assists at Saginaw Valley State (1/23) ... Had two points along with one rebound and assist in consecutive contests versus Northern Kentucky (12/28) and against Hillsdale (1/2) ... **2001-02:** Appeared in 25 games while making three starts ... Averaged 3.5 points and 1.6 rebounds per game ... Tallied 23 assists and 11 steals ... Scored a career-best nine points at Northern Michigan (2/3) ... Added eight points and three rebounds in nine minutes of action at Grand Valley State (2/11) ... Had five points, three steals and three rebounds in Ferris' league opener at Findlay (11/29) ... Totaled seven points and three rebounds vs. Mercyhurst (12/8) ... Registered at least one point in 21 outings.

**High School:** A 2001 graduate of Royal Oak Shrine High School ... Averaged 21.5 points per game as a senior (2000-01) ... Led the Knights in rebounding (10.0 rpg) and assists (4.0 apg) ... Named to the 2001 Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan (BCAM) All-Star Team ... Was a fourth-team *Detroit News* Class C All-State selection ... Earned honorable mention all-state honors as a junior ... Two-time team Most Valuable Player Award winner ... Three-year varsity basketball starter ... Served as team captain ... Garnered All-Catholic League laurels twice ... Prepped by Mike Massucci ... Three-time all-county and all-area pick ... Won the Shrine Knight Award as a sophomore ... Also earned three varsity letters in football and one in track.

Mother works as an executive assistant while his father is a support system service representative ... Was a four-year honor roll student ... Served on the high school diversity day committee ... 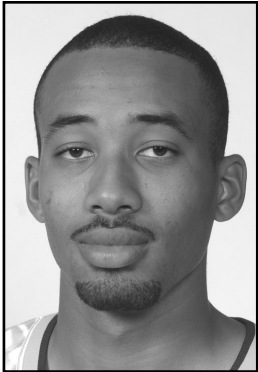

**College:** **2004-05:** Focused player ... Runs floor well ... Fits squad's style of play ... Continues to improve defensively ... **2003-04:** Started five games and appeared in 26 contests ... Tallied six double-figure scoring performances ... Twice posted a season-high 16 points – at Northwood (2/21) and versus Saginaw Valley State (2/12) ... Scored 13 points and had seven rebounds at Michigan Tech (2/5) ... Produced 13 points and six rebounds at Northern Michigan (2/8) ... Ranked fifth among team leaders in both scoring (6.3 ppg) and rebounding (3.7 rpg) ... Placed fourth on squad in made free throws (26) ... Registered 11 points versus Grand Valley State (1/10) ... Netted 10 points and four rebounds at Hillsdale (1/15) ... Tallied seven points in his Bulldog debut at Lewis, Ill. (11/15) ... Grabbed eight rebounds at Northwood (2/21) ... Played 445 total minutes ... Shot 42.9% (66-154) from the field ... Had six points and six rebounds while converting three-of-five (.600) field goal attempts in Ferris' win over Michigan Tech (2/28) for the GLIAC North Division title ... Averaged nine points per game in his final nine outings of the season ... Placed 19th among GLIAC's overall season offensive rebounding leaders (1.73 pg).

**Junior College:** Averaged 21.5 points and 12 rebounds per game ... Led MCC to a 21-8 overall record and a Michigan Community College Athletic Association (MCCAA) playoff berth in 2002-03 ... Attained second-team NJCAA All-America recognition along with first-team MCCA All-State, NJCAA All-Region XII and MCCA All-Western Conference accolades ... Totaled 624 points and 347 rebounds ... Ranked ninth in rebounding and 15th in scoring among NJCAA's overall leaders ... Totaled 16.5 points and 7.6 rebounds per game in 2001-02 ... Coached by Gene Gifford ... Selected as team Most Valuable Player.

**High School:** A 2001 graduate of Muskegon Heights High School ... Led MHHS to a regional semifinal round appearance in 2000-01 while averaging 14.6 points per game as a senior ... All-Academic honoree ... Named team MVP ... Also participated in cross country along with track and field ... Prepped by Lee Gilbert.
