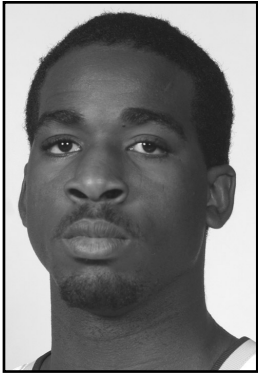


MEET THE 2004-05 BULLDOGS

College: 2004-05: Has established himself as a low post threat ... Asked to find consistency ... Determined and focused athlete ... 2003-04: Started 22 of 27 outings ... Chosen as team's Most Improved Player Award recipient ... Posted 10 double-figure scoring contests ... Compiled a season-best 16 points in FSU's final game of the year versus Northwood (3/2) ... Registered 15 points twice – at Northern Michigan (2/8) and versus Wayne State (1/17) ... Recorded 14 points and five rebounds at Cornerstone (11/22) ... Grabbed nine rebounds and scored 12 points at Findlay (12/4) ... Led squad in rebounding (4.9 rpg) and ranked fourth in scoring (8.4 ppg) ... Placed third among team leaders in made free throws (41) and fourth in field goals (90) ... Garnered 13 points at Hillsdale (1/15) ... Ranked tied for 20th place among GLIAC rebounding leaders and was fourth in offensive rebounds (2.52 pg) ... Notched four points and four rebounds in his collegiate debut at NCAA Division I Central Michigan (11/17).

High School: A 2003 graduate of Murray-Wright High School ... Tallied 15.1 points and 11.4 rebounds per game as a senior ... Guided team to a 19-3 overall record and a Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) Class A State Semifinal appearance in 2002-03 ... Was an honorable mention 2002-03 *Detroit Free Press* and *Detroit News* Class A All-State selection ... Scored a team-high 22 points and had four steals in the Pilots' 62-61 state semifinal loss to Rockford (3/21) ... Attained third-team 2002-03 Detroit Public School League (PSL) kudos ... Received honorable mention All-Metro accolades and third-team All-Detroit honors from the *Detroit Free Press* and *Detroit News* ... All-Conference honoree ... Prepped by Earl Moore ... Served as team captain ... Also participated in cross country and track and was a three-year letterwinner in both sports.

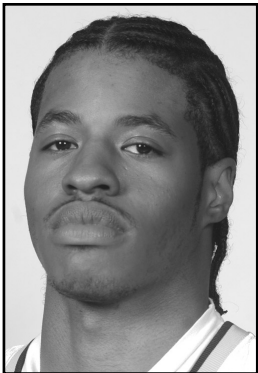

College: 2004-05: Will be squad's go-to-guy ... Versatile and productive all-around player ... One of league's top defensive players ... 2003-04: Ranked second among team's leading scorers (14.8 ppg) ... Named team Defensive MVP ... Honored as first-team All-GLIAC North Division and GLIAC All-Defensive Team pick ... Tallied personal career-highs in points (413), steals (66) and three-pointers (72) ... Placed fourth nationally in three-point percentage (.503) and 23rd in steals (2.4 spg) ... Led GLIAC in both categories ... Recorded 18 double-figure scoring outings and nine 20-plus point contests ... Compiled a career-best 34 points at Lake Superior State (2/14) while setting a school record for three-point percentage (6-6) ... Sank 11-of-11 free throw attempts vs. Gannon (1/22) ... Had 30 points vs. Northwood (1/29) and at Calvin (1/3) ... Named GLIAC North Division Player of the Week (1/12) ... 2002-03: Started all 26 games ... Received team Defensive MVP Award accolades ... Placed third among team's scoring leaders (11.6 ppg) and had a team-high 51 steals ... Ranked fourth in steals (1.96 spg) among league leaders ... Totaled 17 double-figure scoring contests ... Led team in steals nine times ... 2001-02: Started 22 contests ... Was the squad's second-leading rebounder (5.0 rpg) ... Tallied Ferris' eighth-best (58) all-time single-season steals mark ... Ranked third among the GLIAC's steals leaders (2.42 spg) and seventh (2.46 rpg) in the league's offensive rebound category ... Scored in double-figures 11 times ... Had three double-double performances, including 21 points and 10 rebounds at Calvin (12/1) ... Netted a team-high 20 points at Grand Valley State (2/11).

High School: A 2001 graduate of Benton Harbor High School ... Was the team's top three-point shooter as a senior (2000-01) ... Ranked among the team's leading scorers (15.2 ppg) ... Led BHS to a 25-1 mark and a berth in the Class A state quarterfinals ... Also was a member of the varsity cross country and baseball teams ... Prepped by Paul Wilhite ... Helped the Tigers win Big Eight Conference, district and regional titles ... Earned team's Sixth Man Award.

Personal: Son of Nanci Epps of Benton Harbor, Mich. ... Born 7/17/83 in St. Joseph, Mich. ... Was a three-year National Honor Society member ... Mother works as a teacher's assistant ...
