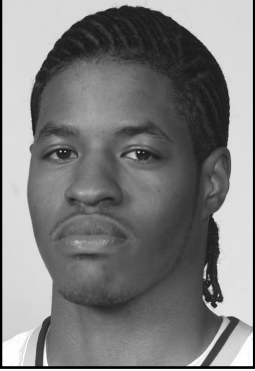


## MEET THE 2004-05 BULLDOGS

**College: 2004-05:** Improved player ... Solid outside shooter ... Productive defensive player ... **2003-04:** Played in all 28 games ... Received team's Sixth Player Award ... Reached double-figure scoring six times ... Registered a career-high 21 points at Grand Valley State (2/16) ... Scored 15 points at Calvin (1/3) ... Netted 14 points versus Mercyhurst (1/24) ... Placed third on squad in three-pointers (31), fourth in both assists (4.0 apg) and steals (1.4 spg) along with fifth in scoring (6.3 ppg) ... Ranked 15th in steals (1.43 spg) and 16th in three-point percentage (.378) among GLIAC leaders ... Twice dished out six assists ... **2002-03:** Appeared in all 26 contests ... Recorded 11 double-figure scoring outings ... Totaled a season-high 17 points to lead Ferris at Grand Valley State (1/18) ... Grabbed a squad-best six rebounds at Lewis (12/19) ... Led the team in three-point field goal percentage (.385) and was fifth in scoring (8.8 ppg) ... Scored 13 points and grabbed seven boards vs. Lake Superior State (2/6) ... **2001-02:** Appeared in 26 games and started 14 contests ... Registered eight double-figure scoring performances ... Garnered 18 points at Calvin (12/1) ... Tallied 16 points and four rebounds at Northwood (1/17) ... Had a team-high 15 points in Ferris' victory over Olivet (11/20) ... Scored 11 points twice – at Findlay (11/29) and vs. Grand Valley State (1/19) ... Finished second (1.7 spg) among the squad's steals leaders and third (2.3 apg) in assists ... Held team's third-best (.727) free throw percentage mark ... Was 12th overall among the GLIAC's steals leaders (1.69 spg) and finished tied for the league's second-best single-game steals total with six against Grand Valley State (1/19).  
**High School:** A 2001 graduate of Benton Harbor High School ... Helped lead the Tigers to the Big Eight Conference Championship, the district title and the regional crown as a senior ... Coached by Paul Wilhite ... Earned the Most Improved Player Award as a senior ... Averaged 10.1 points per game and six rebounds a contest (2000-01) ... Also participated in cross country and baseball ... Earned two varsity basketball letters, three baseball letters and four cross country letters ... Guided the Tigers to a 25-1 mark and a state quarterfinal appearance as a senior.  
**Personal:** Son of Nanci Epps of Benton Harbor, Mich. ... Born 7/17/83 in St. Joseph, Mich. ... National Honor Society member ... Mother is employed as a teacher's assistant ... Interests include video games and drawing ... Majoring in computer information systems ... Twin brother of teammate Carlton Epps ... Has three other siblings.

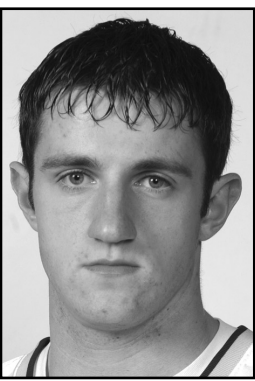

**College: 2004-05:** Tremendous role player ... Provides a spark on the floor ... Effective rebounder ... Continues to develop overall skills ... **2003-04:** Appeared in 27 games ... Started initial 11 contests ... GLIAC All-Academic Team honoree ... Scored 10 points or more five times ... Registered 14 points and six rebounds at Cornerstone (11/22) ... Grabbed 14 rebounds at Ashland (12/6) ... Tallied 12 points and 10 rebounds at Findlay (12/4) ... Placed 15th among GLIAC's offensive rebound leaders (1.85 pg) ... Netted eight points in four of final seven contests ... Was squad's second-leading rebounder (4.2 rpg) ... **2002-03:** Played in all 26 outings ... Presented the squad's Most Improved Player Award ... Was the squad's field goal percentage leader (.548) ... Scored 52 points in the final 13 games after totaling 39 points in the initial 13 outings ... Totaled 91 points and 56 rebounds ... Scored eight points and grabbed six rebounds at Northern Michigan (2/20) ... Tallied eight points along with six boards at Ashland (1/11) ... Recorded eight points and two rebounds at Olivet (12/14) ... Netted seven points against Lincoln, Mo. (12/18) ... Notched 41 of his 56 rebounds in GLIAC play ... Ranked as the squad's sixth-leading scorer (3.5 ppg) ... Garnered six rebounds vs. Northern Kentucky (12/28) ... Twice led the team in blocked shots.  
**High School:** A 2002 graduate of Kearsley High School ... Averaged 18.4 points, 12.4 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game as a senior ... Led the Hornets to a school-record 15-6 overall mark in 2001-02 ... Was a two-time (2001-02) team Most Valuable Player Award winner ... Named a unanimous first-team 2001-02 All-Big Nine Conference selection ... Tallied 15 points and nine rebounds in his junior campaign ... Served as team captain twice (2000-02) and was named to the 2001 Michigan Junior National Basketball Team ... Prepped by Paul Adas ... Garnered third-team 2000-01 all-league honors ... Also competed in track and field for four years and qualified for the 2002 Michigan Lower Peninsula Division 2 State Track and Field Championships.  
**Personal:** Son of Patrick and Carol Shanahan of Flint, Mich. ... Born 5/2/84 in Flint, Mich. ... Involved in Flint Kearsley's robotics program ... Majoring in mechanical engineering technology ...
