#### Florida Gulf Coast Notes:

✓ The Eagles are currently 7-3 overall this season after advancing to the NCAA-II National Tournament last campaign. Fifth-year head coach Dave Balza's squad dropped an 82-78 home decision to North Alabama in its most recent outing (Dec. 19) this campaign. Last year, FGC compiled a 24-7 mark in the program's first season as a full-fledged member of the NCAA and its first season of postseason-eligibility. Balza is a native of South Haven (Mich.) and formerly served as the head coach at Saint Joseph's (Ind.) along with being an assistant coach at GLIAC-member Ashland (Ohio). The Eagles have won two of their last three outings to date.

#### Montevalllo Notes:

✓ The number two ranked Falcons are currently 10-1 overall after a 69-62 setback Dec. 19 at Stillman (Ala.). Montevalllo, which will play Minnesota-Duluth in Thursday's (Dec. 29) opening game of the event, is guided by third-year head coach Danny Young. The squad has won back-to-back Gulf South Conference titles and made two-straight NCAA-II South Regional Tournament appearances in the last two years. UM finished the 2004-05 campaign with a 26-7 overall record while reaching the regional finals. Montevalllo was ranked number one prior to this week's (Dec. 19) ranking.

### FSU GAME NOTES

✓ The Ferris State University men's basketball team will take part in the Florida Gulf Coast Holiday Classic Thursday and Friday, Dec. 29-30, in Fort Myers, Fla. The Bulldogs square off against host Florida Gulf Coast Thursday (Dec. 29) at 8 p.m. (EST) and will then meet Montevallo (Ala.) in Friday's (Dec. 30) 3:30 p.m. (EST) contest. Ferris is presently 7-4 overall this campaign.

✓ Ferris State University is a NCAA Division II school located in Big Rapids, Mich., with an enrollment of 12,547. The Bulldogs are a member of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC). Big Rapids is located in West Michigan approximately 60 miles north of Grand Rapids or 40 miles west of Mount Pleasant, Mich.

✓ No Ferris State radio or internet coverage will be available for either of the non-conference games.

✓ Ferris' current 4-0 league start is the program's best since winning five-straight to open the 1989-90 campaign. FSU posted a perfect 16-0 league record in 1988-89.

✓ Ferris State was listed as a possible breakthrough squad in the 2005-06 *Street & Smith's* College Basketball Magazine Division II Preview. The annual list of teams, which was compiled by Chuck Mistovich of the *Basketball Times*, included a preseason top 10 list and 30 additional teams receiving possible breakthrough recognition.

✓ The 2005-06 campaign marks the 78th season of Bulldog men's basketball. The program began in 1925 although Ferris did not field a team from 1942-45 due to World War II. FSU has compiled a 923-847 (.521) all-time mark. The Bulldogs have won 11 GLIAC titles, made seven NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and reached the 1988 NCAA-II Elite Eight.

✓ This year's event will be Florida Gulf Coast's fourth annual Holiday Classic in ALICO Arena. Minnesota-Duluth joins Ferris, Montevallo and Florida Gulf Coast in the four-team field.

### BULLDOG BITES

✓ Ferris capped off a banner 2004-05 season with a runner-up finish in the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament (March 12-15) held in Findlay, Ohio. FSU reached the regional championship game for only the third time in school history last season. The Bulldogs, who won their second-straight GLIAC North Division Championship with a 13-5 league mark last campaign, concluded the year with a 24-7 overall record and fell one game shy of advancing to the NCAA-II Elite Eight for the second time ever. FSU's 24 victories represented the third-most wins in school history.

✓ Ferris State was ranked 18th overall in the 2005-06 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division II Preseason Top 25 poll. GLIAC member Findlay was seventh in the poll with regional foe Southern Indiana listed ninth. FSU was not ranked but did receive votes in this week's (Dec. 19) regular-season poll.

✓ Two-time defending divisional champion Ferris State was picked to finish third in the 2005-06 GLIAC Men's Basketball Coaches Preseason North Division Poll. The Bulldogs totaled 28 points along with one first-place vote in the balloting, which was conducted by the conference's head coaches. Northern Michigan was selected as the North Division favorite while Findlay took the top spot in the South Division.

✓ A 1994 Calvin College graduate, fourth-year FSU head coach **Bill Sall** previously held assistant coaching positions at Calvin (1992-95), Ferris State (1995-98) and Hillsdale (1998-02) prior to being named Ferris State's 11th head coach. The Zeeland, Mich., native served as Ferris' interim head coach for a portion of the 1995-96 campaign and led the Bulldogs to a 5-8 mark. Including his stint as interim coach, Sall has a current 61-48 (.560) career mark. He is 56-40 (.583) overall since being appointed head coach prior to the 2002-03 campaign.

✓ The Bulldogs have posted an impressive 30-8 (.789) overall record at Jim Wink Arena in **Bill Sall's** head coaching era. Ferris, which holds an all-time mark of 38-37 (.507) to date in the seven year old facility, registered a

school-best 15-1 (.938) record at home during the 2004-05 campaign.

✓ Ferris' 2005-06 roster includes three seniors, three juniors, two sophomores and four freshmen. Six of the 12 players are guards while the remaining six are frontcourt players. Eleven of the 12 players hail from Michigan with **Dennis Springs** the only out-of-state player on the roster.

✓ FSU's three seniors will serve as the squad's team captains this campaign. They include **Dennis Springs**, **Antwuan Holt** and **Jeffery Shanahan**. Both Springs and Shanahan are returning three-year letterwinners while Holt played his first two collegiate seasons at GLIAC-member Northern Michigan before his transfer to FSU.

✓ The Bulldogs had posted only a 21-82 (.204) mark in the four seasons prior to current head coach **Bill Sall's** arrival, but have since went 56-40 (.583). FSU won only four games (4-22) the year before Sall arrived in 2001-02.

✓ The Bulldogs will face their fourth nationally-ranked team of the season in second-ranked Montevallo at the FGC Holiday Classic. FSU beat then 19th-ranked Grand Valley State (Dec. 8) after falling to currently fourth-ranked Saint Joseph's (Ind.) in their season opener (Nov. 15). Ferris also suffered an 88-81 setback to fifth-ranked Southern Indiana (Dec. 20) in the GLIAC/Great Lakes Valley Conference Challenge at Indianapolis, Ind.

✓ FSU's **Dennis Springs** and **Terrance Shaw** were chosen among the top 10 West Michigan collegiate players to watch this year by the *Grand Rapids Press* in the Nov. 15 edition. Springs was picked second overall while Shaw was the seventh player listed.

✓ Ferris has claimed the GLIAC North Division Player of the Week Award three times in the four weeks it has been awarded this season as **Terrance Shaw** was recognized as the most recent (Dec. 12) selection. The honor previously went twice to FSU's **Dennis Springs** on both Nov. 22 and Dec. 5.
