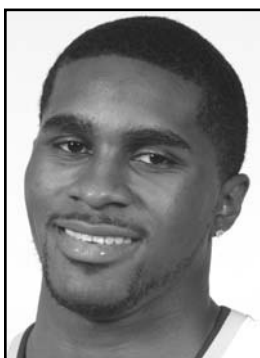

Led team to Class B State Semifinals in 2003-04 after winning regional title at FSU's Jim Wink Arena for second-straight season ... Averaged 18.6 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.6 steals per game in his final campaign ... Helped Muskegon Heights capture both its third consecutive district and regional title under first-year head coach and former Ferris State men's basketball player Keith Guy (1995-97) ... Selected to play in the annual Ta-Wa-Si high school benefit all-star boys basketball game ... Totaled 46 made three-pointers as a senior ... Sparked the Tigers to a 21-4 record under current Central Michigan University Assistant Coach Lamar Chapman in 2002-03 while earning MHSAA Class B State Runner-Up plaudits ... Received third-team *Detroit Free Press* Class B All-State kudos in his junior campaign.
