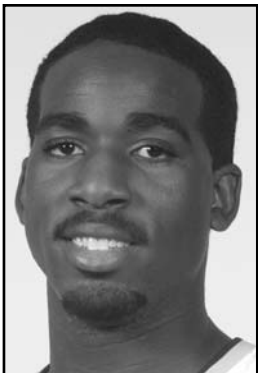


MEET THE 2005-06 BULLDOGS

College: 2005-06: Asked to become more of an inside presence offensively ... Improved strength and mobility ... Good competitor ... **2004-05:** Started 23 contests ... Reached double-figure scoring four times ... Tallied a career-high 10 rebounds vs. Findlay (12/2) ... Scored 12 points at Gannon (1/20) ... Had 11 points in season opener vs. Cornerstone (11/16) ... Also had 10 points at Saginaw Valley State (12/11) and at Northern Michigan (2/24) ... Ranked second on team in field goal percentage (.503) ... **2003-04:** Started 22 of 27 outings ... Chosen as team's Most Improved Player Award recipient ... Posted 10 double-figure scoring contests ... Compiled a season-best 16 points in FSU's final game of the year versus Northwood (3/2) ... Registered 15 points twice – at Northern Michigan (2/8) and versus Wayne State (1/17) ... Recorded 14 points and five rebounds at Cornerstone (11/22) ... Grabbed nine rebounds and scored 12 points at Findlay (12/4) ... Led squad in rebounding (4.9 rpg) and ranked fourth in scoring (8.4 ppg) ... Placed third among team leaders in made free throws (41) and fourth in field goals (90) ... Garnered 13 points at Hillsdale (1/15) ... Ranked tied for 20th place among GLIAC rebounding leaders and was fourth in offensive rebounds (2.52 pg) ... Notched four points and four rebounds in debut at NCAA Division I Central Michigan (11/17).
High School: A 2003 graduate of Murray-Wright High School ... Tallied 15.1 points and 11.4 rebounds per game as a senior ... Guided team to a 19-3 overall record and a Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) Class A State Semifinal appearance in 2002-03 ... Was an honorable mention 2002-03 *Detroit Free Press* and *Detroit News* Class A All-State selection ... Scored a team-high 22 points and had four steals in the Pilots' 62-61 state semifinal loss to Rockford (3/21) ... Attained third-team 2002-03 Detroit Public School League (PSL) kudos ... Received honorable mention All-Metro accolades and third-team All-Detroit honors from the *Detroit Free Press* and *Detroit News* ... All-Conference honoree ... Prepped by Earl Moore ... Served as team captain ... Also participated in cross country and track and was a three-year letterwinner in both sports.

College: 2005-06: Likely to see increase in offensive production ... Focused on having a great senior season ... Improved overall play since last season ... Solid outside shooter with ability to slash to the basket ... **2004-05:** Played in 30 games and made five starts ... Was team's sixth-leading scorer (7.3 ppg) and ranked second in assists (2.9 apg) ... Tied for second on squad in three-point percentage (.443) ... Notched season-high 20 points in win over Southern Indiana at NCAA-II Tournament ... Tallied double-figure scoring in final four contests ... Scored 10 points or more in nine contests ... Claimed team Most Improved Player Award laurels ... Also had 18 points vs. Southern Indiana in FSU's Lions Club Holiday Classic (12/20) ... Recorded 17 points at Northwood (1/26) ... Netted 14 points against Aquinas (11/20) ... Totaled 12 points and dished out seven assists vs. Findlay (12/2) ... Registered seven assists vs. Indianapolis (12/21) ... **2002-04:** Spent initial two collegiate campaigns (2002-04) at Northern Michigan ... Ranked as the Wildcats' third-leading scorer (10.1 ppg) ... Posted team bests in minutes (792), made free throws (63), assists (63), steals (39) and three-point percentage (.434) ... Totaled 12 double-figure scoring games in 2003-04 ... Ranked 16th in GLIAC's overall rankings in free throw percentage (.700) and steals (1.39 spg) along with 25th in assists (2.25 apg) ... Sank 33-of-76 (.434) three-point field goals, which placed fifth overall among league leaders ... Started 14 contests in 2002-03 ... Averaged 10.5 ppg ... Earned team Newcomer of the Year Award ... Scored 10 points or more 15 times ... Led squad in free throws (79).

High School: A 2002 graduate of Okemos High School ... Led OHS to league and district championships in his final two campaigns ... Two-year varsity letterwinner ... Earned both team and conference MVP recognition as a senior (2001-02) ... Was a fourth-team all-state honoree and earned first-team all-conference kudos ... Prepped by Dan Stolz.

Personal: Son of Elbert and Darlene Holt of East Lansing, Mich. ... Born 5/16/84 in Los Angeles, Calif. ... Marketing major ... Averaged 11.5 points per game and posted two double-digit scoring efforts in four meetings against the Bulldogs while at NMU.
