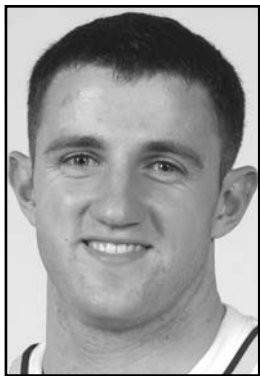


MEET THE 2005-06 BULLDOGS

College: 2005-06: Brings tremendous energy ... Provides a spark ... Effective rebounder ... Does all the little things ... **2004-05:** Appeared in all 31 games ... Started seven times ... Named to GLIAC All-Academic Team ... Recorded season-best 13 rebounds along with 13 points in NCAA Tourney regional finals vs. Findlay (3/15) ... Led squad in rebounding (5.3 rpg) and field goal % (.521) ... Recorded double-figure points in three contests ... Had career-high tying 14 points at Alma (12/28) ... Totaled 10 boards vs. Calvin (11/23) ... Ranked 11th in offensive boards and 17th in rebounding among GLIAC's overall leaders ... **2003-04:** Appeared in 27 games ... Started initial 11 contests ... GLIAC All-Academic Team honoree ... Scored 10 points or more five times ... Registered 14 points and six rebounds at Cornerstone (11/22) ... Grabbed 14 rebounds at Ashland (12/6) ... Tallied 12 points and 10 rebounds at Findlay (12/4) ... Placed 15th among GLIAC's offensive rebound leaders (1.85 pg) ... Was squad's second-leading rebounder (4.2 rpg) ... **2002-03:** Played in all 26 outings ... Team's Most Improved Player ... Was the squad's field goal % leader (.548) ... Scored 52 points in the final 13 games ... Scored eight points and grabbed six rebounds at Northern Michigan (2/20) ... Tallied eight points along with six boards at Ashland (1/11) ... Recorded eight points and two rebounds at Olivet (12/14) ... Notched 41 of his 56 rebounds in GLIAC play ... Ranked as the squad's sixth-leading scorer (3.5 ppg).

High School: A 2002 graduate of Kearsley High School ... Averaged 18.4 points, 12.4 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game as a senior ... Led Hornets to a school-record 15-6 overall mark in 2001-02 ... Two-time (2001-02) team MVP ... First-team 2001-02 All-Big Nine Conference selection ... Tallied 15 points and nine rebounds as a junior ... Served as team captain twice (2000-02) and was named to the 2001 Michigan Junior National Basketball Team ... Prepped by Paul Adas ... Qualified for the 2002 Michigan Lower Peninsula Division 2 State Track and Field Championships.

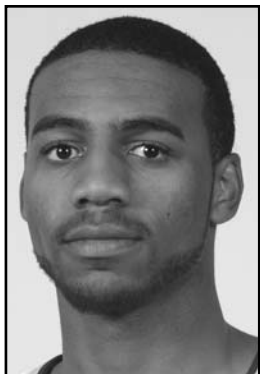

College: 2005-06: Among league's most athletic players ... Has incredible reach and wing span ... Expected to be a major contributor and improve consistency ... **2004-05:** Started 29 of squad's 31 outings ... Scored 10 points or more nine times ... Tallied a career-high 18 points vs. Indianapolis (12/21) ... Notched 10 boards vs. Hillsdale (1/11) ... Ranked 11th in GLIAC in blocked shots (1.0 bpg) ... Placed third on squad in rebounding (4.5 rpg) and fifth in scoring (8.1 ppg) ... Netted 17 points at Lake Superior State (12/9) ... **2003-04:** Saw action in 26 contests ... Started one game ... Totaled three double-figure scoring outings ... Had 14 points and eight rebounds at Saginaw Valley State (12/13) ... Scored 14 points and grabbed five boards versus Indianapolis (12/19) ... Placed tied for 13th in blocked shots (0.73 bpg) among league leaders ... Ranked third on squad in field goal percentage (.468) and was second in blocks ... Registered 11 points and six rebounds at NCAA Division I Central Michigan (11/17) ... Compiled nine points and five boards versus Northern Michigan (2/26) ... Blocked three shots in FSU's win over Michigan Tech (2/28) ... Had eight rebounds and three blocks versus Gannon (1/22) ... Scored eight points in lone start versus St. Xavier, Ill. (11/21) ... Converted four-of-four (1.000) field goal attempts for eight points vs. Mercyhurst (1/24) ... Tallied 111 points and 94 rebounds ... Sank first career three-pointer in season finale vs. Northwood (3/2).

High School: A 2003 graduate of Bridgeport High School ... Averaged 21 points and 11 rebounds per game as a senior ... Led Bearcats to a 14-7 overall record and district semifinal finish in 2002-03 ... Attained first-team 2002-03 Associated Press Class B All-State recognition along with second-team honors from the *Detroit News* and fourth-team *Detroit Free Press* accolades ... Third-team *MichiganPreps.com* Class B All-State pick ... Two-time (2002-03) *Saginaw News* Class B First-Team All-Area honoree ... Two-time first team Tri-Valley Conference East Division pick ... Two-year letterwinner ... Guided the Bearcats to a district championship in 2001-02 ... Also played football and ran track ... Broke the school's high jump record ... Played Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) basketball for the Michigan Mustangs.
