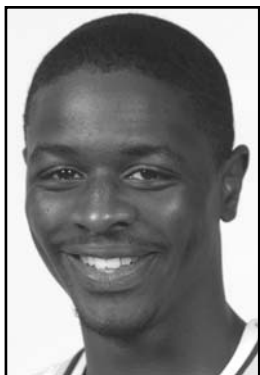

College: 2005-06: One of league's top players ... Provides leadership ... Serves as squad's quarterback ... **2004-05:** Started 30 of 31 outings ... Second-Team All-GLIAC North Division and GLIAC All-Defensive Team honoree ... NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional All-Tourney Team ...

Ranked among GLIAC leaders in seven categories ... Set school records for career and single-season assists ... Finished second in league in assists ... Was team's second-leading scorer (12.8 ppg) ... Served as team captain ... Hit buzzer-beating overtime shot to lift FSU past rival Grand Valley State (2/7) ... Totaled 24 double-digit scoring games ... Dished out 12 assists four times ... Scored 20 or more points four times ... **2003-04:** Made 27 starts ... Second-Team GLIAC North Division pick ... Named to GLIAC All-Defensive and All-Academic Teams ... Led league in assists (6.19 apg) and was fifth in steals (1.89 spg) ... Was squad's third-leading scorer (10.8 ppg) ... Had 17 double-digit scoring outings ... Dished out 13 assists vs. Grand Valley State (1/10) ... Had eight or more assists in 11 contests ... Finished 16th nationally in assists ... GLIAC North Division Player of the Week (3/1) ... **2002-03:** Started all 26 contests ... Totaled 155 assists ... Led team in assists (6.0 apg), was second in steals (1.9 spg) and fourth in scoring (11.3 ppg) ... Was GLIAC's assists leader and ranked third in assist/turnover ratio (1.96) ... Registered triple-double performance with 16 points, 13 assists and 10 steals vs. Calvin (11/26) ... Scored 22 points and had six rebounds at Olivet (12/14) ... Recorded 15 double-figure scoring performances ... Notched 10 assists or more in five outings ... Ranked 19th nationally in assists (6.0 apg) ... **2001-02:** Attended Bowling Green State, but did not play basketball.

High School: A 2001 graduate of Scott High School in Toledo, Ohio ... Third-team 2000-01 Ohio High School Athletic Association Division I All-Stater ... Averaged 15.5 ppg as a senior ... Two-time (2000-01) All-Toledo City League pick ... Named *Toledo Blade's* 2001 Player of the Year ... Prepped by Earl Morris.

Personal: Son of Dennis and Jackie Springs of Toledo, Ohio ... Born 10/22/82 in Toledo, Ohio ... Majoring in business education ... Participated in Bowling Green State's Upward Bound college preparation program ... Father is employed by Ford Motor Company while his mother is a public school driver.

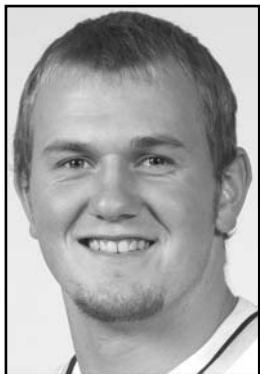

College: 2005-06: One of team's top competitors ... Understands the game ... Versatile two-sport athlete ... Can play three different spots on floor ... **2004-05:** Appeared in initial two games before suffering season-ending injury against Aquinas (11/20) ... Grabbed five rebounds in 17 minutes of action ... **2003-04:** Appeared in 20 contests ... Compiled 46 points, 15 rebounds and 11 assists ... Scored nine points and sank four-of-six (66.7%) field goal attempts at Hillsdale (1/15) ... Totaled nine points and five rebounds versus Glenville State, W.Va. (12/30) ... Netted five points at Grand Valley State (2/16) ... Recorded five points and two steals versus Indianapolis (12/19) ... Tallied two points and one rebound in his collegiate debut versus Lake Superior State (12/11) ... Notched two points along with both one rebound and assist as FSU claimed the GLIAC North Division Championship with a victory over Michigan Tech (2/28) ... Led team in field goal percentage by making 18-of-37 (48.6%) of season field goal attempts.

High School: A 2003 graduate of West Ottawa High School ... Totaled 22 points and 11 rebounds per game in 2002-03 ... Led WOHS to a school-record 15-7 overall record and a district semifinal finish ... Team Captain ... Garnered 2002-03 *Detroit Free Press* Class A Sixth-Team All-State and *Associated Press* Class A Honorable Mention All-State kudos ... Third-team 2002-03 *Grand Rapids Press* All-Area Dream Teamer ... Twice (2002-03) attained first-team All-Ottawa-Kent (OK) Red Conference recognition ... *Holland Sentinel* All-Area pick ... Coached by Von Washington ... Three-time all-conference quarterback ... Threw for 2,139 yards and 29 touchdowns in senior year to rank 20th all-time among state single-season passing leaders and sixth in TD's ... Guided Panthers to most wins in school history (8-3) and first-ever playoff victory in 2002 ... First-Team 2002 Class A All-State football honoree ... Two-year varsity baseball letterwinner.

Personal: Son of James and Diane Van Wieren of Holland, Mich. ... Born 2/27/85 in Holland, Mich. ... Also playing football at Ferris State ... Has played on special teams and started three games at quarterback during fall 2005 season ... Named GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week after rushing for 194 yards and throwing for 219 more vs. Mercyhurst (9/24) ... Earned West Ottawa's Scholar-Athlete Award ... Majoring in elementary education ... Enjoys the outdoors.
