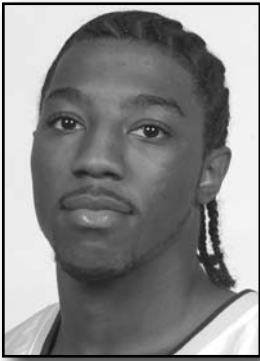


MEET THE 2006-07 BULLDOG NEWCOMERS

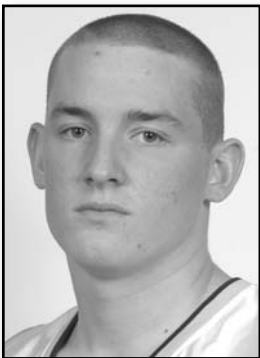
College: Redshirted during the 2005-06 campaign.

Iron Mountain, Mich.**



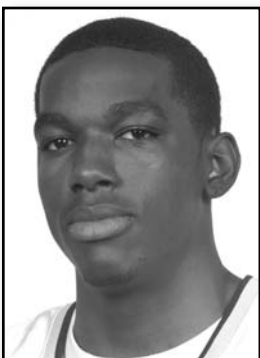

Team earned state runner-up honors in Class B his junior season (2004-05) ... Helped team to a 26-2 overall record as a junior ... Tallied nine points, six blocked shots and five rebounds in squad's 67-60 loss to Grand Rapids South Christian in 2005 Michigan Class B State Championship Game at the Breslin Center in East Lansing (Mich.) ...
