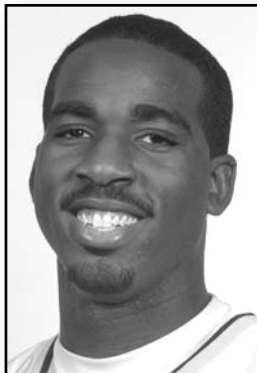


MEET THE 2006-07 BULLDOGS

College: 2006-07: In best shape of career ... Expected to become consistent force at both ends ... Team captain ...

2005-06: Made 27 starts ... Ranked as team's third-leading rebounder (4.4 rpg) and fifth-leading scorer (8.2 ppg) ... Had 11 double-figure scoring contests ... Tallied 10 rebounds or more in three contests ... Posted two double-double efforts ... Tied for second on team with 22 blocked shots ... **2004-05:** Started 23 contests ... Reached double-figure scoring four times ... Tallied a career-high 10 rebounds vs. Findlay (12/2) ... Scored 12 points at Gannon (1/20) ... Had 11 points in season opener vs. Cornerstone (11/16) ... Also had 10 points at Saginaw Valley State (12/11) and at Northern Michigan (2/24) ... Ranked second on team in field goal percentage (.503) ... **2003-04:** Started 22 of 27 outings ... Chosen as team's Most Improved Player Award recipient ... Posted 10 double-figure scoring contests ... Compiled a season-best 16 points in FSU's final game of the year versus Northwood (3/2) ... Registered 15 points twice – at Northern Michigan (2/8) and versus Wayne State (1/17) ... Recorded 14 points and five rebounds at Cornerstone (11/22) ... Led squad in rebounding (4.9 rpg) and ranked fourth in scoring (8.4 ppg) ... Placed third among team leaders in made free throws (41) and fourth in field goals (90) ... Notched four points and four rebounds in debut at NCAA Division I Central Michigan (11/17).

High School: A 2003 graduate of Murray-Wright High School ... Tallied 15.1 points and 11.4 rebounds per game as a senior ... Guided team to a 19-3 overall record and a Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) Class A State Semifinal appearance in 2002-03 ... Was an honorable mention 2002-03 *Detroit Free Press* and *Detroit News* Class A All-State selection ... Attained third-team 2002-03 Detroit Public School League (PSL) kudos ... Received honorable mention All-Metro accolades and third-team All-Detroit honors from the *Detroit Free Press* and *Detroit News* ... All-Conference honoree ... Prepped by Earl Moore ... Served as team captain ... Also participated in cross country and track and was a three-year letterwinner in both sports.
