College: 2006-07: Athletic ... Top returning scorer and rebounder ... Team captain ... **2005-06:** Was team's second-leading scorer (13.0 ppg) and top rebounder (6.8 rpg) ... Among GLIAC's overall leaders in six categories ... Scored career-high 25 points and grabbed career-best 14 boards in NCAA-II Tournament loss at nationally second-ranked Saint Joseph's (3/11) ... Had 10 or more points in 22 contests ... Compiled four double-double efforts ... All-GLIAC Second Team ... Named to GLIAC All-Tourney Team ... GLIAC Player of the Week ... **2004-05:** Started 29 of squad's 31 outings ... Scored 10 points or more nine times ... Tallied a career-high 18 points vs. Indianapolis (12/21) ... Notched 10 boards vs. Hillsdale (1/11) ... Ranked 11th in GLIAC in blocked shots (1.0 bpg) ... Placed third on squad in rebounding (4.5 rpg) and fifth in scoring (8.1 ppg) ... Netted 17 points at Lake Superior State (12/9) ... **2003-04:** Saw action in 26 contests ... Started one game ... Totaled three double-figure scoring outings ... Had 14 points and eight rebounds at Saginaw Valley State (12/13) ... Scored 14 points and grabbed five boards versus Indianapolis (12/19) ... Placed tied for 13th in blocked shots (0.73 bpg) among league leaders ... Ranked third on squad in field goal percentage (.468) and was second in blocks ... Registered 11 points and six rebounds at NCAA-I Central Michigan (11/17) ... Scored eight points in start vs. St. Xavier, Ill. (11/21).

Led Bearcats to a 14-7 overall record and district semifinal finish in 2002-03 ... Third-team *MichiganPreps.com* Class B All-State pick ... Two-time (2002-03) *Saginaw News* Class B First-Team All-Area honoree ... Two-time first team Tri-Valley Conference East Division pick ... Two-year letterwinner ... Guided the Bearcats to a district championship in 2001-02 ... Also played football and ran track ... Broke the school's high jump record ... Played Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) basketball for the Michigan Mustangs.

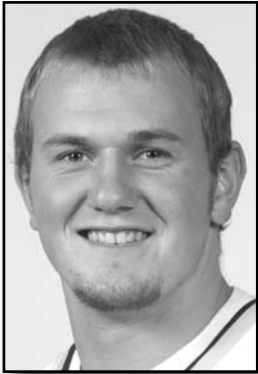

College: 2006-07: Fierce competitor ... Returning starter ... Plays hard ... Solid defensive player ... **2005-06:** Started 27 of 31 contests ... Netted 112 points and 65 rebounds ... Had nine points in season-opener at Saint Joseph's (11/15) ... Placed among league leaders with 30 steals in league play ... Had 31 total assists and 39 steals on the year ... Scored eight points in three different contests ... **2004-05:** Appeared in initial two games before suffering season-ending injury against Aquinas (11/20) ... Grabbed five rebounds in 17 minutes of action ... **2003-04:** Appeared in 20 contests ... Compiled 46 points, 15 rebounds and 11 assists ...
