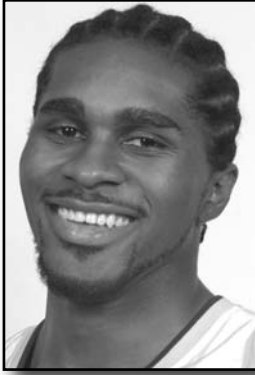

College: 2006-07: Team leader and captain ... One of squad's best defenders ... Saw considerable action last season ... Expected to increase offensive production this year ... **2005-06:** Started four games and played in all 31 contests ... Named team Most Improved Player Award recipient ... Started three of the squad's final five outings, including NCAA-II Tournament contest at nationally second-ranked Saint Joseph's (3/11) ... Twice scored nine points in a game, including season-opener at Saint Joseph's (11/15) ... Shot 80% from the free throw line (32-40) on the season ... Averaged 24 minutes of playing time in final seven games ... Had six rebounds in a pair of contests ... Scored at least one point in 29 of the 31 games during the year ... Also totaled 31 assists, 20 steals and three blocked shots ... Nailed 11 three-pointers ... Averaged 4.5 points and 3.1 rebounds per contest.

Junior College: Attended Eastern Michigan University in 2004-05 but did not play collegiate basketball ... Previously played two seasons from 2002-04 at Muskegon Community College ... Averaged a team-high 19.4 points and compiled 78 assists along with 41 steals in his final season (2003-04) of junior college basketball ... All-Conference pick ... Coached by Gene Gifford ... Team MVP ... Served as team captain ... Led squad to a 21-8 overall record and runner-up finish in the Michigan Community College Athletic Association Western Conference as a freshman (2002-03) ... Honorable mention all-conference in initial season.

High School: A 2002 graduate of Muskegon Heights High School ... Received fifth-team *Associated Press* Class C All-State accolades as a prep senior (2001-02) ... Led the Tigers to the Michigan Class C State Semifinals and a 21-4 mark as a senior ... Tallied a team-leading 17 points per game in his final season ... Chosen as team co-MVP ... Team captain.

College: 2006-07: Regarded as one of team's top outside threats ... Played significantly as a freshman last campaign ... Continues to develop all-around game ... Has made major strides since his arrival at Ferris ... **2005-06:** Appeared in all 31 games and scored 271 points ... Was squad's fourth-leading overall scorer (8.7 ppg) ... Also recorded 65 rebounds, 38 assists, 34 steals and three blocked shots ... Nailed 53 three-pointers, which ranked third among team leaders ... Placed among GLIAC's top 15 leaders in made three-pointers and three-point percentage during league play ... Totaled 15 double-figure scoring performances, including a season-high 22 at Saginaw Valley State (12/3) ... Played 718 total minutes on the year ... Sank 24-of-27 (.889) free throw attempts and shot 36.3% (53-146) from three-point range ... **2004-05:** Redshirted during the 2004-05 campaign.

High School: A 2004 graduate of Muskegon Heights High School ... Attained *Detroit News* and *Associated Press* Class B All-State First Team recognition along with second-team Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan (BCAM) Class B laurels in 2003-04 ... Guided MHHS to a 25-2 overall mark as a senior ... Claimed 2003-04 *Muskegon Chronicle* All-Area Dream Team kudos ... Led team to Class B State Semifinals in 2003-04 after winning regional title at FSU's Jim Wink Arena for second-straight season ... Averaged 18.6 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.6 steals per game in his final campaign ... Helped Muskegon Heights capture both its third consecutive district and regional title under first-year head coach and former Ferris State men's basketball player Keith Guy (1995-97) ... Selected to play in the annual Ta-Wa-Si high school benefit all-star boys basketball game ... Totaled 46 made three-pointers as a senior ... Sparked the Tigers to a 21-4 record under current Toledo University and former Central Michigan University Assistant Coach Lamar Chapman in 2002-03 while earning MHSAA Class B State Runner-Up plaudits ... Received third-team *Detroit Free Press* Class B All-State kudos in his junior campaign.
