## **FERRIS STATE TO HOST GLIAC/GLVC Challenge Event Includes Four Great Lakes Regional Squads**

The Ferris State women's basketball team will host the GLIAC/GLVC Challenge Friday and Saturday, Nov. 23-24, at FSU's Jim Wink Arena in Big Rapids, Mich.

The classic will feature four NCAA Division II women's basketball contests involving two schools apiece from both the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) and the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC). In addition to the host Bulldogs, the field also includes Southern Illinois-Edwardsville and Kentucky Wesleyan of the GLVC along with GLIAC member Lake Superior State.

The event is being sponsored by the Country Inn and Suites of Big Rapids.

Friday's games feature LSSU against KWC at 4 p.m. (EST) followed by Ferris-SIUE beginning at 6 p.m. (EST). The Lakers will battle SIUE Saturday at 4 p.m. (EST) with Ferris taking on KWC in the 6 p.m. (EST) contest.

### **Jim Wink Arena: The Site Of The 2007 GLIAC/GLVC Challenge**

The new Jim Wink Arena in the FSU Sports and Convocation Complex became the home of the Ferris State University men's and women's basketball programs on Nov. 30, 1999. The 2,400-seat arena replaced Old Wink Arena, which had housed the men's basketball team since the 1963-64 campaign. The Bulldog men's and women's teams are presently midst their ninth season of action in the facility.

The need for a new court became necessary after plans were revealed to remodel Old Wink Arena and the remainder of the Health and Physical Education (HPE) Building. The project, which resulted in the state-of-the-art Student Recreation Center, began immediately following the completion of the 1997-98 basketball season.

Ferris State was without a home basketball court in 1998-99 as construction continued on its new arena, forcing the Bulldogs to play their home games at Big Rapids High School. Construction on the new facility began in July 1998 when Granger Construction broke ground on the project, and was completed in September 1999.

The basketball programs moved into an arena that includes locker rooms, athletic training facilities and equipment rooms. In addition to standard bleachers, 350 luxury chair-back seats were installed on the North side of the court. The expanded lobby area between Wink Arena and Ewigleben Ice Arena includes restrooms, concession stands, a ticket office and pro shop.

The arena is named after legendary men's basketball coach Jim Wink. Wink, who passed away Aug. 26, 1987, won a team-record 326 games while coaching the men's program from 1959-81 and was inducted into the Bulldog Athletics Hall of Fame in 2000.

### TEAM NOTES

Kentucky Wesleyan opened the 2007-08 campaign with a 68-64 home win over nationally 19th-ranked Grand Valley State last Friday (Nov. 16) ..... Seven letterwinners return from last season's 18-10 squad that placed tied for third in the GLVC East Division (11-8) ..... The Panthers produced the second most wins in school history last year ..... KWC has made two-straight trips to the GLVC Tourney Quarterfinals ..... Senior forward Laura McClintic led the Panthers in scoring versus GVSU with a team-high 14 points ..... Kentucky Wesleyan was picked to finish third in the GLVC East Division Preseason Coaches Poll this campaign ..... The squad is directed by fifth-year head coach Ron Williams ..... Senior forward LaTasha Henry is the squad's leading returning scorer from a year ago after averaging 13.1 points per contest in 2006-07 ..... The Panthers are 0-2 all-time versus Ferris State and have never faced Lake Superior State in school history.
