BULLDOG BITES

✓**FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE:** The Ferris State women's basketball team hosts archrival Grand Valley State in a "Big Monday" matchup this Monday evening (Jan. 12) starting at 6 p.m. (EST) inside FSU's Jim Wink Arena at Big Rapids, Mich. The Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) outing opens a five-game homestand for the Bulldogs. In conjunction with the game, the Ferris Athletics Department will give away t-shirts to the first 200 FSU students in attendance at the contest. Second semester classes begin at Ferris on Monday as well.

✓**MEDIA COVERAGE:** The game is slated to be carried live by Bulldog Radio on Charter TV Channel 21 in Mecosta County with Gilbert Bransford handling the play-by-play duties. A live audio/video pay-per-view webcast will also be offered by B2 Networks. Live internet statistics will also be available. Visit the FSU Athletics Website at www.ferris.edu/sports and click on internet event schedule for a complete list of all available links.

✓**TICKET INFO:** Tickets for Monday's doubleheader against Grand Valley State will be available at the door starting one hour prior to the women's tipoff. All single-game general admission ticket prices are \$7. FSU students are admitted free with ID. For more information on home ticket sales, please contact the FSU Athletics Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888.

✓**EARLIER THIS YEAR:** Earlier this year (12/1/08), the Bulldog women opened Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) action with a 74-64 road triumph over Grand Valley State in Allendale, Mich., while the men's squad narrowly lost to the nationally-ranked Lakers by a 72-62 count inside GVSU's Fieldhouse Arena.

✓**RECENT HISTORY:** Last season (2/23/08), the Bulldogs drew a modern Wink Arena record crowd of 2,430 fans for the regular-season men's basketball finale against the Lakers, which was also played in front of the first-ever live television audience from the arena. The official women's halftime attendance of 1,640 fans for the "Fill The Wink" contest also represented the largest crowd ever to watch the FSU women play in the 2,400-seat facility. Ferris has broke its own men's basketball arena attendance mark against GVSU each of the last three seasons and four of the top six men's crowds in the building's history have come against Grand Valley State. The Bulldogs have had more than 1,000 fans for the women's contest versus the Lakers at Wink Arena each of the last three years.

✓**CASH OFFERING:** Ferris State students will have an opportunity to win cash at each Bulldog basketball doubleheader the rest of the season. The FSU Athletics Department will give away a \$100 certificate at each of the Bulldogs' 11 GLIAC doubleheaders this campaign. In order to win the prize on a given day, students must be in attendance prior to halftime of the women's basketball contest. A raffle drawing will be held to determine the winner in the second half of the men's game.

✓**RECENT RESULTS:** The Bulldogs dropped two league road games this past weekend. FSU suffered a 67-52 setback in Thursday's (Jan. 8) game to Lake Superior State in Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., and then dropped a narrow 68-63 decision Saturday (Jan. 10) at Saginaw Valley State in University Center, Mich. The Bulldogs led the Cardinals by 10 points in the opening half of Saturday's game before SVSU rallied to snap a 10-game losing skid.

✓**THE LEADERS:** The Bulldogs took the loss at SVSU on Saturday despite 17 points from senior forward/center Jenna Guay (Escanaba). Sophomore forward Tiara Adams (Lansing/Waverly) was the only other FSU player to reach double-figure scoring with 13 points against the Cardinals. Senior guard/forward Caitlin Hutchison (Riverview) was the lone Bulldog player to reach double-figure scoring at Lake Superior State with 13 points as FSU managed to shoot only 25% (17-68) from the floor for the game.

✓**LAST SEASON:** Ferris State, which advanced to the NCAA Division II Sweet Sixteen for the first time in school history two years ago, wrapped up the 2007-08 season with a 17-12 overall record and placed tied for third in the GLIAC North Division with a 11-7 league mark. The Bulldogs return nine letterwinners and four starters this season.

✓**TWO YEARS AGO:** Ferris, which advanced to the NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Championship Game for the first time ever two years ago, was ranked 25th nationally in the final 2006-07 USA Today/ESPN NCAA Division II Top 25 Poll. The Bulldogs, who prior to 2006-07 had never won a NCAA Tournament game, recorded back-to-back wins in their first two national tourney contests en route to the regional runner-up finish. Ferris also compiled a second-place tying 13-5 GLIAC regular-season finish and earned the program's eighth consecutive GLIAC Tournament bid two seasons ago.

✓**HEAD COACH TRACEY DOROW:** Eleventh-year FSU head coach Tracey Dorow (formerly Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk) presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 178-117 (.603) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, she guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tourney appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. She spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at Indianapolis (1997-98). She also directed FSU to an NCAA Tourney berth in 2003-04 before the Bulldogs' run to the Sweet Sixteen in 2006-07.

✓**THE FSU ROSTER:** Ferris' 2008-09 roster includes four seniors, one junior, five sophomores and three freshmen. Seven of the 13 players are guards while the remaining six are frontcourt players. All 13 players on the roster hail from Michigan.

MORE BULLDOG NOTES

✓ **THE BULLDOG TRADITION:** The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 35th season of varsity competition, has compiled a 431-442 (.494) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which claimed GLIAC Tourney runner-up honors in 1999-00 and 2003-04, has posted 10 or more victories 12 consecutive seasons.

✓ **FSU PICKED THIRD:** Ferris State was picked to finish third in the 2008-09 GLIAC Women's Basketball North Division Preseason Poll, which was announced during the league's media day teleconference (Oct. 30). The poll was chosen by selected members of the media and the GLIAC's Sports Information Directors. The 30-member group tabbed Michigan Tech and Hillsdale to win the conference's North and South Division titles, respectively. The Bulldogs totaled 121 points in the balloting and trailed MTU's first-place 179 points and Grand Valley State's 134 points.

✓ **PRESEASON ALL-GLIAC:** FSU senior guard **Teghan Thelen (Pewamo/Westphalia)**, who averaged 10.4 points per contest a year ago, was one of five players named to the Preseason All-GLIAC North Division squad in voting by the league's member head coaches. Five players were also named to the South Division team with Hillsdale's Katie Cezat earning GLIAC Preseason Player of the Year laurels.

✓ **BULLDOG BITES:** Senior guard **Teghan Thelen** is currently FSU's leading scorer this season with a 13.9 points per game scoring average while **Caitlin Hutchison** is also averaging in double-figures at 10.8 points a contest **Caitlin Hutchison** has reached double-figure scoring in six of the last seven games while **Tiara Adams** has scored 10 points or more in five of the last seven contests to date this year FSU presently holds an all-time mark of 74-29 (.718) in the 10-year history of the modern Jim Wink Arena.

✓ **MARYGROVE NOTES:** The Bulldogs' 108 total points versus Marygrove (Dec. 29) represented the first time FSU has scored more than 100 points since a 104-78 home win over Lake Superior State last February (2/16). It also was the second-straight time the Bulldogs have topped the century mark against Marygrove and tied for the third-highest single game scoring output in school history Against Marygrove, FSU finished only four points shy of matching the school record of 112 points set in a 112-49 home win over Westminster back during the 1999-00 season (12/2/99), which came in the first-ever contest played inside the current Wink Arena.

✓ **RECORD BREAKER:** The eight three-pointers made by **Teghan Thelen** versus Kentucky Wesleyan in this year's season opener (Nov. 15) surpassed former Bulldog Lori Young's school-record seven treys made at Michigan Tech back during the 1992-93 campaign (12/12). Her 36 points also tied for the third-highest single-game figure in Bulldog history while her 67% (8-12) effort behind the arc is the second best mark all-time at FSU.

✓ **MORE ON TEGHAN:** FSU's **Teghan Thelen** was Ferris' second-leading scorer (10.4 ppg.) last season behind departed All-GLIAC First Team pick Rachel Folcik and added 119 rebounds, 85 assists along with 35 steals in starting 25 of 29 games. Her 50 made three-pointers led the squad and ranked as the 10th-best seasonal figure in school history. She also had 19 double-figure scoring games. Thelen currently ranks sixth in school history with 124 career three-pointers made and is among the top 10 performers in school career three-point percentage (.355). Her 85.0% (102-120) career free throw percentage is the best mark in school history to date. A three-year letterwinner, Thelen scored 10 points or more in 11 games as a sophomore during the 2006-07 season, including four consecutive contests to end the year, as the Bulldogs reached the NCAA-II Sweet Sixteen.

✓ **TOP OF THE LIST:** Ferris head coach **Tracey Dorow** became the school's all-time victory leader with two wins in the Aquinas College Classic (Nov. 18-19) to open the 2005-06 season in Grand Rapids, Mich. Dorow, who also ranks as FSU's all-time winningest coach, surpassed Pat Dolan's (1977-89) previous school-record total of 118 wins at FSU. All three of Ferris' NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances have come under Dorow. She was honored as the GLIAC's 2003-04 Women's Basketball Coach of the Year.

✓ **ALL IN THE FAMILY:** FSU's **Tracey Dorow** is far from the only coach in her family. She previously spent three seasons as an assistant coach under her father, **Rick Bloodworth**, at Lake Michigan College in Benton Harbor, Mich. Her father is serving as a volunteer assistant coach at Ferris for the third year in a row this season after a long stint as LMC's head coach. In addition, her younger sister, **Andrea Bloodworth**, currently is midst her second year as an assistant women's coach at NCAA-I Liberty following two years in a similar role at NCAA-I Valparaiso (Ind.) along with three years as the top assistant at GLIAC-member Gannon.

✓ **SCOUTING GVSU:** GVSU holds a 10-2 overall record and is 6-1 in the GLIAC to date following a 80-66 league win at Lake Superior State on Saturday (Jan. 10). Grand Valley State has won seven consecutive games and has not lost since dropping its GLIAC opener at home to Ferris State (Dec. 1) by a 74-64 count at Allendale, Mich. The Lakers are led in scoring by senior forward Kim Wyngaard (14.1 ppg). GVSU, which won the NCAA-II National Championship in 2005-06, finished 16-12 overall and tied for third place in the GLIAC North Division (11-7) last campaign. Grand Valley State is guided by second-year head coach Janel Burgess. The squad's only other loss was a 73-62 setback at nationally-ranked Drury (Mo.) in the fourth game of the year (Nov. 22) at Springfield, Mo.

✓ **SERIES INFORMATION:** GVSU holds a 49-24 advantage heading into Monday's 74th encounter. FSU has won six of the last 13 series' contests, including a 74-64 triumph at Allendale earlier this year (Dec. 1) for its second-straight win at the GVSU Fieldhouse Arena. The Lakers came back to record a 69-62 triumph in last year's regular-season finale (2/23/08) at Big Rapids. The Bulldogs have won three of the last four games overall. FSU head coach **Tracey Dorow** currently has a 12-11 career coaching record against the Lakers.

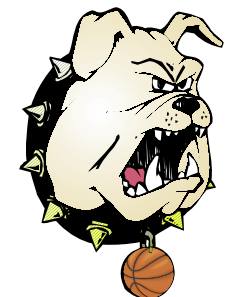

The 2005-06 squad was honored for having the nation's 20th-highest cumulative grade point average in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll. It marked the seventh consecutive year Ferris had placed among the nation's top 25 academic teams.

The Bulldogs compiled a 3.350 grade point average in 2005-06. FSU was ranked the highest of the two GLIAC member institutions ranked in the top 25 as Gannon placed 21st (3.343).

The Bulldogs, who previously compiled the nation's highest gpa (3.534) in 1999-00, also finished 21st (3.313) in 2001-02 and were 20th (3.388) for the 2000-01 academic year. Ferris' 3.604 gpa in 2002-03 placed second and also represented the fifth-best figure among teams from both the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Divisions I, II and III levels along with those representing National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) institutions. FSU was 17th overall (3.384) in 2003-04 before placing 14th overall (3.432) in the 2004-05 campaign.

The WBCA Top 25 Team Honor Roll list annually recognizes the nation's highest programs based upon nominations submitted by WBCA-member head coaches.
