BULLDOG BITES

✓**FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE:** The Ferris State women's basketball team wraps up Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) regular-season play on the road this week as the Bulldogs first visit Northwood on Thursday, Feb. 26, for a 6 p.m. (EST) league tilt in Midland, Mich. Ferris then travels to Wayne State for its last regular-season contest on Saturday, Feb. 28, with tipoff set for 1 p.m. (EST) in Detroit, Mich. FSU has currently won five consecutive games to date along with seven of its last 10 contests.

✓**MEDIA COVERAGE:** Both games will be carried live by Bulldog Radio on Charter TV Channel 21 in Mecosta County or at www.bulldogradio.org. A live audio/video pay-per-view webcast will be offered for both games by B2 Networks. Live internet statistics will also be available. Visit the FSU Athletics Website at www.ferris.edu/sports and click on internet event schedule for a complete list of all available links.

✓**TICKET INFO:** Tickets for both doubleheaders will be available at the door. For more information on ticket sales, please contact the NU or WSU athletics offices, respectively. To obtain ticket information for Thursday's game at Northwood, please call the NU Athletics Office at (989) 837-4381. WSU's main office number is (313) 577-4280.

✓**THE STANDINGS:** The Bulldogs are currently among four teams fighting for the final three spots in the GLIAC Postseason Tournament with two games left. FSU owns a 9-11 league mark to date and is sixth in the league's overall standings. They lead Lake Superior State, Findlay and Northern Michigan all by one game (8-12). This year, the top eight teams overall will qualify for the GLIAC Tournament with the top four seeds earning first-round home games. Five teams have clinched tournament berths heading into the final week of regular-season play.

✓**THE TOURNEY:** Ferris has advanced to the GLIAC Tournament on 10 different occasions, including the last nine years in a row to date. The annual GLIAC Postseason Tournament will begin with four quarterfinal-round games at campus sites next Tuesday, March 3. The top remaining seed will then host the semifinals/finals Friday and Saturday, March 6-7, with the tournament winner receiving the league's automatic bid into the NCAA-II Regional March 13-16. FSU will be on the road at a site and time to be determined for Tuesday's quarterfinal. The official pairings and times will be announced after this week's play.

✓**TOURNEY SCENARIOS:** A number of possible scenarios still exist involving the four teams fighting for the final three spots. FSU needs only a single win to assure itself of a spot in the tournament. The Bulldogs would earn the league's sixth seed by winning each of their final two games and then would travel to the tournament's third seed, which would likely be either Northwood or Grand Valley State. Ferris split with both Lake Superior State along with Findlay and owns a sweep over Northern Michigan should tiebreakers become involved.

✓**NEWEST LITTLE BULLDOG:** Ferris welcomed its newest "little Bulldog" to the world on Monday (Feb. 23) as FSU head coach **Tracey Dorow** and her husband, Rob, announced the birth of their first child, a daughter named **Lainie Joy Dorow**. She was born at Mecosta County General Hospital in Big Rapids and weighed eight pounds, seven ounces with a length of 21 1/2 inches. One of her grandfathers is third-year FSU volunteer assistant coach **Rick Bloodworth**. Assistant Coach **Crystal Harris** is handling the women's basketball daily operations in Dorow's absence with the aid of the program's two volunteer assistant coaches in **Mark DeNoyelles** and **Bloodworth**.

✓**HOME COURT SWEEP:** Ferris swept its final two home games last week with wins over Saginaw Valley State and Lake Superior State by scores of 81-69 and 69-66, respectively. On Thursday (Feb. 19) night, Ferris jumped out to a 20-point lead in the opening half and cruised past Saginaw Valley State on "Pink Wave Night" at Wink Arena. FSU had three players reach double-figure scoring versus SVSU. Junior center **Andrea Clancy (Port Austin/North Huron)** led the way with a team-high 13 points. Both senior guard **Teghan Thelen (Pewamo/Westphalia)** and sophomore guard **Chelsea Simonetti (Olivet)** chipped in with 10 points apiece. On Saturday (Feb. 21), Thelen tallied 21 points as the Bulldogs topped LSSU on "Senior Day". Meanwhile, senior forward/center **Jenna Guay (Escanaba)** chipped in with 12 points, nine rebounds, three blocked shots and two assists. Senior forward/center **Ashley Fleming (Posen/Rogers City)** closed out the home portion of her career with a double-double effort as she had 11 points and 10 rebounds. Senior guard **Caitlin Hutchison (Riverview)** added four points.

✓**SENIOR DAY:** FSU honored its four seniors in **Teghan Thelen, Ashley Fleming, Jenna Guay** and **Caitlin Hutchison** following their final regular-season home contests last Saturday against LSSU. All four players are in their fourth season at FSU and have combined to help the Bulldogs post a four-year mark of 69-44 entering this week's action. Together, the quartet has tallied 2,466 career points and 1,300 career rebounds to date.

✓**HEAD COACH TRACEY DOROW:** Eleventh-year FSU head coach **Tracey Dorow** (formerly Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk) presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 186-122 (.604) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, she guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tourney appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. She spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at Indianapolis (1997-98). She also directed FSU to an NCAA Tourney berth in 2003-04 before the Bulldogs' run to the Sweet Sixteen in 2006-07.

MORE BULLDOG NOTES

✓**LAST SEASON:** Ferris State, which advanced to the NCAA Division II Sweet Sixteen for the first time in school history two years ago, wrapped up the 2007-08 season with a 17-12 overall record and placed tied for third in the GLIAC North Division with a 11-7 league mark. The Bulldogs return nine letterwinners and four starters this season.

✓**TWO YEARS AGO:** Ferris, which advanced to the NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Championship Game for the first time ever two years ago, was ranked 25th nationally in the final 2006-07 USA Today/ESPN NCAA Division II Top 25 Poll. The Bulldogs, who prior to 2006-07 had never won a NCAA Tournament game, recorded back-to-back wins in their first two national tourney contests en route to the regional runner-up finish. Ferris also compiled a second-place tying 13-5 GLIAC regular-season finish and earned the program's eighth consecutive GLIAC Tournament bid two seasons ago.

✓**THE FSU ROSTER:** Ferris' 2008-09 roster includes four seniors, one junior, five sophomores and three freshmen. Seven of the 13 players are guards while the remaining six are frontcourt players. All 13 players on the roster hail from Michigan.

✓**THE BULLDOG TRADITION:** The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 35th season of varsity competition, has compiled a 439-447 (.495) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which claimed GLIAC Tourney runner-up honors in 1999-00 and 2003-04, has posted 10 or more victories 12 consecutive seasons.

✓**PRESEASON ALL-GLIAC:** FSU senior guard **Teghan Thelen**, who averaged 10.4 points per contest a year ago, was one of five players named to the Preseason All-GLIAC North Division squad in voting by the league's member head coaches. Five players were also named to the South Division team with Hillsdale's Katie Cezat earning GLIAC Preseason Player of the Year laurels.

✓**BULLDOG BITES:** Ferris currently ranks third in the GLIAC in field goal percentage (.453), three-point percentage (.363) and assists (16.6 apg.) Senior **Caitlin Hutchison** ranks seventh in field goal % (.517) among the league leaders while **Teghan Thelen** is sixth in three-pointers made (2.0 pg.) and **Chelsea Simonetti** is seventh in assist/turnover ratio (1.5) **Caitlin Hutchison** needs six points to notch her 500th career point while **Ashley Fleming** is 18 points away from the same figure **Jenna Guay** tallied her 600th career point last Saturday versus LSSU FSU is listed fourth in the GLIAC and ninth nationally in free throw percentage (.778) this year This year marks the 13th consecutive season and 18th time in the last 19 years the Bulldogs have reached double-digit victories in a campaign. FSU has won at least 11 games in all 13 years under head coach **Tracey Dorow** to date.

✓**ACADEMIC HONOR:** FSU's **Caitlin Hutchison** has been honored as a 2009 ESPN *The Magazine* Academic All-District IV First Team pick in voting conducted by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Hutchison's selection marks the eighth time in the last nine years the Bulldogs have had a player named to the five-member district first team.

✓**GLIAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** FSU's **Ashley Fleming** was named last week's (Feb. 16) GLIAC North Division Player of the Week after posting back-to-back double-double (points and rebounds) performances in wins over Michigan Tech (Feb. 12) and Northern Michigan (Feb. 14). The 6-1 Fleming scored 15 points and grabbed a game-high 13 boards with three assists, two blocks and a steal while hitting six-of-nine (.667) shots in FSU's upset over nationally 12th-ranked MTU. She then scored a team-high tying 13 points and pulled down 11 boards with four assists and a blocked shot as FSU topped NMU in overtime. Fleming totaled 28 points, 24 rebounds, seven assists and three blocked shots in the two games combined. She's the third Bulldog player to claim the league's weekly award this season, joining **Teghan Thelen** and **Jenna Guay**.

✓**NEAR THE TOP:** FSU's **Teghan Thelen** currently ranks third in school history with 147 career three-pointers. Thelen now is 37 away from Erin Miller's second-place total of 184 three-pointers. Thelen's 50 made three-pointers last season led the squad and ranked as the 10th-best seasonal figure in school history. She currently is among the top 10 performers in school career three-point percentage (.350). Her 86.2% (119-138) career free throw percentage is the best mark in school history to date. Thelen is 18 points shy of scoring her 900th career point.

✓**SCOUTING NORTHWOOD:** The Timberwolves are guided by fifth-year head coach Jeff Curtis and tied for their first-ever GLIAC North Division Championship last season. NU is led by junior Jodi Ostergren (15.8 ppg.), who ranks fifth in the league in scoring to date. Northwood has won seven of its last nine outings and is 19-6 overall along with 14-6 in the GLIAC to date. Northwood was 18-9 overall in 2007-08 and 13-5 in the GLIAC's North Division. NU lost to Ashland 74-68 in its most recent action Sunday (Feb. 22) at Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio.

✓**SCOUTING WAYNE STATE:** WSU is presently 7-18 overall and 5-15 in GLIAC action heading into Thursday's (Feb. 26) home game versus Grand Valley State after last Saturday's (Feb. 21) 76-58 league road win at Tiffin. Wayne State, which is led in scoring by junior guard Brooke Bowers (12.0 ppg.), was 15-12 overall in 2007-08 and placed fourth (9-8) in the GLIAC's South Division. The Warriors are coached by ninth-year head coach Gloria Bradley.

✓**SERIES INFORMATION:** The Bulldogs maintain a 43-14 advantage over Northwood all-time and are 22-6 (home), 21-7 (road) and 0-1 (neutral) to date versus NU. FSU lost to NU in the most recent outing earlier this year (Jan. 24) by a 83-67 count in Big Rapids. Ferris beat Northwood twice in Midland last season, including a 93-89 (3/1/08) triumph during the 2008 GLIAC Tourney Quarterfinals after NU had posted a 68-64 victory in Big Rapids (1/14/08) to snap a 24-game series' losing skid for its first victory over FSU since 1995. FSU head coach **Tracey Dorow** owns a 20-2 career mark to date versus NU The Bulldogs maintain a 31-24 series' advantage entering Saturday's 56th meeting and defeated WSU 77-74 in the last meeting (1/22/09) this year at Big Rapids. Dorow presently has a 11-1 career coaching record against the Warriors. Ferris has won 11 of the last 12 series' encounters to date.

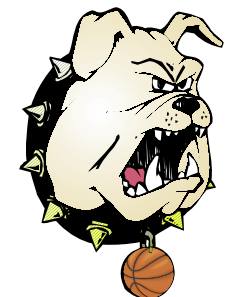

The Ferris State women's basketball team has achieved success in more ways than one under 11th-year head coach **Tracey Dorow**.

The 2005-06 squad was honored for having the nation's 20th-highest cumulative grade point average in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll. It marked the seventh consecutive year Ferris had placed among the nation's top 25 academic teams.

The Bulldogs compiled a 3.350 grade point average in 2005-06. FSU was ranked the highest of the two GLIAC member institutions ranked in the top 25 as Gannon placed 21st (3.343).

The Bulldogs, who previously compiled the nation's highest gpa (3.534) in 1999-00, also finished 21st (3.313) in 2001-02 and were 20th (3.388) for the 2000-01 academic year. Ferris' 3.604 gpa in 2002-03 placed second and also represented the fifth-best figure among teams from both the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Divisions I, II and III levels along with those representing National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) institutions. FSU was 17th overall (3.384) in 2003-04 before placing 14th overall (3.432) in the 2004-05 campaign.

The WBCA Top 25 Team Honor Roll list annually recognizes the nation's highest programs based upon nominations submitted by WBCA-member head coaches.
