BULLDOG BITES

FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE: The Ferris State University women's basketball squad will take on top-seeded Michigan Tech in the 2009 Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Tournament Semifinals on Friday, March 6, at Houghton, Mich. Tipoff is set for 5 p.m. (EST) inside MTU's Student Development Complex Gymnasium.

MEDIA COVERAGE: There will be no local radio coverage available for Tuesday's game. However, a live audio/video pay-per-view webcast will be offered by B2 Networks. TICKET INFO: Tickets for the semifinals/finals may be purchased at the door one hour prior to the start of each session. Reserved seat tickets are \$9 while general admission tickets are \$7 and student tickets (ages 5 and up) \$2 per session. GLIAC guidelines do not permit any complimentary tickets to be issued. An All-Tournament pass is also available for either \$12 (reserved) or \$10 (general admission). For additional ticket information, please contact the MTU's Central Ticket Office at (906) 487-2073.

THE RECORDS: The Bulldogs presently hold a 13-14 overall record and were 10-12 in conference regular-season play this year. MTU currently holds a 23-5 mark this campaign and is ranked 18th nationally in the latest poll. Ferris has won seven of its last eight contests to date.

QUARTERFINAL WIN: The Bulldogs advanced to the semifinals with a 73-68 upset of third-seeded Northwood on Tuesday (March 3) evening in Midland, Mich. Senior forward/center **Ashley Fleming (Posen/Rogers City)** led four Bulldog players in double-figure scoring with 14 points. Senior guard **Teghan Thelen (Pewamo/Westphalia)** added 12 points, senior forward/center **Jenna Guay (Escanaba)** chipped in with 11 points and senior guard/forward **Caitlin Hutchison (Riverview)** netted 10 points as all four Bulldog seniors reached double-digits to extend their careers. FSU had been seeded sixth entering the quarterfinals before avenging two earlier losses this season to Northwood, including a 79-70 road setback in the final week of regular-season play (Feb. 26). The four seniors also combined for 33 rebounds in the game with Guay netting 16 in the outing.

GLIAC TOURNEY FIELD: The teams were reseeded following Tuesday's quarterfinal round. MTU remains the top seed with Hillsdale second, Grand Valley State third and FSU fourth. HC and GVSU will play in Friday's second semifinal at 7 p.m. (EST) with the winners advancing into Saturday's (March 7) 5 p.m. (EST) championship game. In the quarterfinal round, MTU topped Northern Michigan (62-55), Hillsdale beat Lake Superior State (62-60) and GVSU defeated Ashland (59-49). Ferris was the only road team to pull off an upset in the opening round.

FSU TOURNEY NOTES: Including Tuesday's win, Ferris has posted a 8-10 overall record in GLIAC Tournament play. FSU, which is making its 10th-straight and 11th overall women's berth in the GLIAC Tournament, defeated Northwood 93-89 in last year's (3/1/08) tournament quarterfinals at Midland. The Bulldogs then suffered a 56-45 setback in the semifinals (3/7/08) to Ashland in a game held at Houghton, Mich. This year

marked the second-straight year the Bulldogs and Northwood met in the quarterfinals FSU was the tourney runner-up in 1999-00 and 2003-04 Ferris had dropped six of its last eight GLIAC Tourney games heading into Tuesday. However, FSU has now made it past the quarterfinal round in six of its 11 trips to the tourney.

GLIAC TOURNEY NOTEBOOK: The tournament remains on campus sites this season for the seventh year in a row. Prior to the 2002-03 season, the four previous tournaments were held at a neutral site location, with the final three taking place at the DeltaPlex in Grand Rapids, Mich. The winner of this season's GLIAC Tournament will receive the league's automatic berth into the NCAA-II Midwest Regional Tournament slated for March 13-16 at a site to be determined.

THE THIRD MEETING: Friday's meeting will be the third time the Bulldogs and Huskies have met this season. MTU defeated FSU 80-70 earlier this season (1/31/09) at Houghton. However, FSU rebounded for a 67-62 triumph at FSU's Jim Wink Arena in the second meeting (2/12/09) at Big Rapids. MTU holds a 36-23 series edge entering Friday's 60th encounter and has won 12 of the last 19 series' matchups overall.

NEWEST LITTLE BULLDOG: Ferris welcomed its newest "little Bulldog" to the world last Monday (Feb. 23) as FSU head coach **Tracey Dorow** and her husband, Rob, announced the birth of their first child, a daughter named **Lainie Joy Dorow**. She was born at Mecosta County General Hospital in Big Rapids and weighed eight pounds, seven ounces with a length of 21 1/2 inches. One of her grandfathers is third-year FSU volunteer assistant coach **Rick Bloodworth**. Assistant Coach **Crystal Harris** has been guiding the Bulldogs in Dorow's absence with the aid of the program's two volunteer assistant coaches.

LEADING FSU AGAIN: FSU assistant coach **Crystal Harris** will direct the Bulldogs in Friday's contest. Harris has served as the bench coach in five games this year with the Bulldogs owning a 3-2 mark. She coached the team in FSU's trip to the Upper Peninsula earlier this year (Jan. 29 & 31) and also led the squad for the final two games of the regular-season (Feb. 26 & 28) in addition to Tuesday's quarterfinal victory. Harris suffered her first loss as the acting coach when FSU dropped an 80-70 decision to the nationally-ranked Huskies back in January (1/31).

SENIOR CLASS: FSU honored its four seniors in **Teghan Thelen, Ashley Fleming, Jenna Guay** and **Caitlin Hutchison** following their final regular-season home contests against Lake Superior State (Feb. 21). All four players are in their fourth season at FSU and have combined to help the Bulldogs post a four-year mark of 71-45 entering Friday's game. Together, the quartet has tallied 2,598 career points and 1,372 career rebounds.

HEAD COACH TRACEY DOROW: Eleventh-year FSU head coach **Tracey Dorow** (formerly Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk) presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 188-123 (.605) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, she guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tourney appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. She spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at Indianapolis (1997-98). She also directed FSU to an NCAA Tourney berth in 2003-04 before the Bulldogs' run to the Sweet Sixteen in 2006-07.

MORE BULLDOG NOTES

TOURNEY HISTORY: FSU presently owns a 1-0 all-time record against Michigan Tech in GLIAC Tourney action as the Bulldogs recorded a 72-70 home win over the Huskies back during the 2003-04 event at FSU's Jim Wink Arena. Ferris went on to advance to the GLIAC Championship game that year before falling at Lake Superior State. The Bulldogs are 1-1 in the tournament versus Grand Valley State and 0-3 against Hillsdale.

LAST WEEK: Ferris split two league road games to conclude the regular-season last week. The Bulldogs dropped a 79-70 decision at Northwood on Thursday (Feb. 26) before topping Wayne State 69-67 in the final game of the regular-season on Saturday (Feb. 28) in Detroit. Ferris received a strong performance from its own senior class to spoil Wayne State's "Senior Day" outing on Saturday. Senior forward/center **Ashley Fleming** led the way with a game-high 24 points and 13 rebounds. FSU also received 20 points by senior guard **Teghan Thelen** along with 10 points apiece by senior forward **Jenna Guay** and senior guard **Caitlin Hutchison** as four players reached double-digit scoring.

LAST SEASON: Ferris State, which advanced to the NCAA Division II Sweet Sixteen for the first time in school history two years ago, wrapped up the 2007-08 season with a 17-12 overall record and placed tied for third in the GLIAC North Division with a 11-7 league mark. The Bulldogs return nine letterwinners and four starters this season.

TWO YEARS AGO: Ferris, which advanced to the NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Championship Game for the first time ever two years ago, was ranked 25th nationally in the final 2006-07 USA Today/ESPN NCAA Division II Top 25 Poll. The Bulldogs, who prior to 2006-07 had never won a NCAA Tournament game, recorded back-to-back wins in their first two national tourney contests en route to the regional runner-up finish. Ferris also compiled a second-place tying 13-5 GLIAC regular-season finish and earned the program's eighth consecutive GLIAC Tournament bid two seasons ago.

THE FSU ROSTER: Ferris' 2008-09 roster includes four seniors, one junior, five sophomores and three freshmen. Seven of the 13 players are guards while the remaining six are frontcourt players. All 13 players on the roster hail from Michigan.

THE BULLDOG TRADITION: The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 35th season of varsity competition, has compiled a 441-448 (.495) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which claimed GLIAC Tourney runner-up honors in 1999-00 and 2003-04, has posted 10 or more victories 12 consecutive seasons.

PRESEASON ALL-GLIAC: FSU senior guard **Teghan Thelen**, who averaged 10.4 points per contest a year ago, was one of five players named to the Preseason All-GLIAC North Division squad in voting by the league's member head coaches. Five players were also named to the South Division team with Hillsdale's Katie Cezat earning GLIAC Preseason Player of the Year laurels.

BULLDOG BITES: Ferris currently ranks second in the GLIAC in assists (16.7 apg.) along with third in field goal percentage (.453) and rebound margin (+4.6 pg.) in addition to fourth in three-point % (.359) to date Senior **Caitlin Hutchison** ranks seventh in field goal % (.530) among the league leaders while **Teghan Thelen** is sixth in three-pointers made (2.0 pg.) and **Chelsea Simonetti** is seventh in assist/turnover ratio (1.4) Both seniors **Caitlin Hutchison** and **Ashley Fleming** notched their 500th career points last Saturday at Wayne State FSU is listed fourth in the GLIAC and ninth nationally in free throw percentage (.776) this year This year marks the 13th consecutive season and 18th time in the last 19 years the Bulldogs have reached double-digit victories in a campaign. FSU has won at least 11 games in all 13 years under head coach **Tracey Dorow** to date.

ACADEMIC HONOR: FSU's **Caitlin Hutchison** has been honored as a 2009 *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District IV First Team pick in voting conducted by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Hutchison's selection marks the eighth time in the last nine years the Bulldogs have had a player named to the five-member district first team.

GLIAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: The Bulldogs have had three different players earn GLIAC North Division Player of the Week honors this season. **Ashley Fleming** was most recently named the recipient on Feb. 16 after posting back-to-back double-double performances in wins over Michigan Tech (Feb. 12) and Northern Michigan (Feb. 14). She's the third Bulldog player to claim the league's weekly award this season, joining **Teghan Thelen** and **Jenna Guay**.

NEAR THE TOP: FSU's **Teghan Thelen** currently ranks third in school history with 152 career three-pointers. Thelen now is 32 away from Erin Miller's second-place total of 184 three-pointers. Thelen's 50 made three-pointers last season led the squad and ranked as the 10th-best seasonal figure in school history. She currently is among the top 10 performers in school career three-point percentage (.344). Her 86.5% (128-148) career free throw percentage is the best mark in school history to date. Thelen notched her 900th career point last Saturday and Wayne State and presently ranks 17th on the school's career scoring chart.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN TECH: The nationally 18th-ranked Huskies own a current 23-5 record and were 19-3 in league regular-season play while winning the North Division. Michigan Tech is led in scoring by junior forward Katie Wysocky (14.6 ppg) and guided by sixth-year head coach John Barnes. The Huskies were 23-8 overall during the 2007-08 campaign and compiled a first-place 13-5 GLIAC North record. MTU currently owns a 12-2 overall record at home this season.

SERIES INFORMATION: MTU maintains a 36-23 lead over the Bulldogs and has won 12 of the last 19 series' encounters, including a 80-70 home triumph this year (Jan. 31) at Houghton, Mich. However, FSU rebounded for a 67-62 home win in the most recent game (Feb. 12) at FSU's Jim Wink Arena. The Bulldogs are 8-15 overall to date versus MTU in head coach **Tracey Dorow's** coaching tenure.

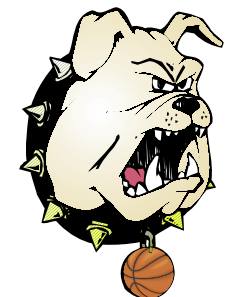
