**ALL-FIVE FIRST TEAM MEMBERS OF 2001/02 DAKTRONICS  
ALL-GREAT LAKES REGION TEAM STILL ALIVE IN HUNT FOR  
NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP**

All five first team members of the 2001-02 Daktronics All-Great Lakes Region Team as selected by the region's Sports Information Directors are still alive in the hunt for the NCAA Division II National Championship Trophy.

Highlighting the First Team are 2000/01 First Team Members Northern Kentucky's Michelle Cottrell (Sr, F, Florence, KY) and Gannon's Kristin Roseberry (Sr, C, Marion, OH). 2001/02 Pepsi/Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournament Most Outstanding Player Jessica Stuckman (So, F, Quincy, IL) from Southern Indiana, Northern Michigan's Marissa Dell Angelo (Sr, G, Negaunee, MI) and Lake Superior State's Alice Deusing (Jr, F, Sault Ste. Marie, MI) round out the first team.

Cottrell is averaging 19 points and 9.4 rebounds per game while shooting 61.1% from the field while Roseberry is averaging a double double with her 18.9 points and 10.2 rebounds per game average and shooting 55.8% from the field. Stuckman is averaging 20.7 points, 7.3 rebounds per game and is shooting 56.5% from the field and 82.4% from the charity stripe. Dell Angelo is averaging 21.1 points and 3.8 rebounds per contest, has dished out 127 assists and recorded 46 steals for Northern Michigan.

These five players will now be placed on the All-American Ballot for Daktronics, Inc., which will be announced on March 19<sup>th</sup>.
