### 5-7 ♦ Senior ♦ Guard Shelby, Mich.

**Coach Fisk on Killips:** "Her role this year will be to look to score more. She has set very high standards for herself and I believe she is very capable of reaching those goals."

**College: 2000-01:** Started all 27 games ... Named to the GLIAC All-Defensive Team and was a second-team All-GLIAC North Division pick ... Earned first-team Verizon All-Academic District IV College Division honors ... Selected as the team's Co-Defensive MVP and the Joan Nelson Academic Award winner ... Was a Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan Athletic/Academic Honor Team member ... Averaged 11.3 points per game and nailed a team-high 43 treys ... Posted the best single-season three-point percentage in school history (.467) ... Established an FSU record with 12 steals versus Ashland (12/2) ... Recorded the second-most single-season assists in Bulldog history (150) ... **1999-00:** Started all 29 games ... Named to the GLIAC All-Defensive Team and the GLIAC All-Tournament Team ... Was a GLIAC All-Academic Team selection ... Ranked third in the conference in steals (3.53 spg) and tied for 13th in assists (3.16) ... Had 15 points, five steals and seven rebounds in the conference tournament against Gannon (3/3) ... Recorded nine steals at Hillsdale (11/22) ... Led the team with 86 steals ... **1998-99:** Had a team-high 51 steals ... Finished second on the team in assists (60) ... Set career highs in points (11) and assists (8) vs. Rochester (11/14) ... Totaled seven steals at Aquinas (12/5) ... Earned the team's Hardest Worker Award.

**High School:** 1998 graduate of Shelby High School ... Named to *The Associated Press, Detroit News, Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan (BCAM),* and BCAM academic all-state teams as a senior ... Averaged 18.0 points, 6.0 steals and 6.0 assists per game in 1997 ... Helped the Tigers to two conference, four district and two regional championships during her four-year varsity career ... Coached by Rick Zoulek ... Was a three-time team Most Valuable Player ... Selected as the *Muskegon Chronicle's* "Female Athlete-of-the-Year" in 1997-98 ... Earned 12 varsity letters in basketball, volleyball and softball.

**Coach Fisk on Larson:** "Even though Patti will not be on the floor, she will still play a leadership role for us. She has done a great job of maintaining a positive attitude through her injury. Our players respect her and will look to her for leadership."

**College: 2000-01:** Saw action in all 27 games ... Made 14 starts ... Tallied four points and seven rebounds versus Clarion (11/24) ... Averaged 2.2 rebounds per game ... Selected as team's Co-Defensive MVP ... Named to the GLIAC All-Academic Team ... Earned FSU's Hardest Worker Award ... Honored as a Dean's Academic Award winner ... **1999-00:** Played in 28 games ... Had a career-high seven points against Northwood (2/24) ... Grabbed a personal-best nine rebounds at Ashland (1/6) ... Recorded a steal and a rebound in the NCAA Tournament against Missouri-St. Louis (3/9) ... Scored four points and had three assists against Westminster in the first contest played at the new Jim Wink Arena (12/2) ... Averaged eight minutes per game in conference play ... Shot 58.3 percent (14-24) from the floor in GLIAC action ... Dished out four assists against Saginaw Valley State (2/5) ... Shot better than 50 percent from the floor in 9-of-14 games in which she had an attempt ... **1998-99:** Played in 23 games ... Scored a career-high five points vs. Rochester (11/14) to help Ferris set team records for points in a game (98) and margin of victory (69) ... Contributed four points at Aquinas (12/5) and vs. Saginaw Valley State (2/20) ... Had four rebounds in a game on four different occasions.

**High School:** 1998 graduate of Kalkaska High School ... Achieved all-conference, all-area, academic all-state and honorable mention all-state honors as a senior ... Set school records for assists in a game (10) and assists in a season (118) while leading the Blazers to a 20-3 record in 1997 ... Averaged 13.0 points, 6.3 rebounds and 5.6 steals per game her final season ... Helped KHS to a 56-9 mark during her three-year varsity career ... Coached by Dave Dalton ... Earned seven letters, three in basketball and four in track ... Qualified for the state track meet as a member of the 3200-meter relay team as a junior ... Was a three-year National Honor Society member.
