**Coach Fisk on Brogger:** "With our lack of size, she will be forced to defend bigger players. That will create a number of mismatch opportunities for her on the offensive end."

**College: 2000-01:** Started 13 games ... Played in all 27 contests ... Scored a career-high 17 points against Grand Valley State (2/12) ... Earned the team's Sixth Player Award ... Had a team-high 43 three-point baskets ... Posted the ninth-best single-season three-point percentage in school history (.467) ... Had a career-best nine rebounds at Southern Indiana (12/29) ... Sank four treys in three games ... Played a season-high 32 minutes and had 10 points at Mercyhurst (1/20) ... Had 17 points and five rebounds against Wayne State (1/13) ... **1999-00:** Appeared in all 29 contests ... Had a career-high six rebounds and 14 points against Mercyhurst (1/17) as she shot 5-of-6 from the floor ... **Coach Fisk on DeMartin:** "For her size and strength, Lucy attacks the basket better than any perimeter player I've seen. She came back this fall and is playing with a lot of confidence. Her speed is an asset and she'll be among the fastest perimeter players in the GLIAC."

**Coach Fisk on Horwitz:** "Bridget has improved her game tremendously over the summer. She will be a scoring threat both inside and outside. She's one of the most mobile post players in the league."

**College: 2000-01:** Played in 26 games ... Made 12 starts ... Tallied a season-high 17 points and four blocked shots in a win over Northern Michigan (2/3) ... Had eight double-figure outings ...
