College: 2001-02: Started all 26 contests ... Averaged 3.3 points and 3.6 rebounds per game ... Named to the GLIAC All-Academic Team ... Attained a personal career-high 11 points at Michigan Tech (1/31) ... Registered 10 points in Ferris' season-opening contest vs. Presbyterian (11/16) ... Grabbed 10 rebounds against St. Joseph's (12/20) ... Accumulated six rebounds in five games ... Totaled eight points at Armstrong Atlantic State (11/17) ... Dished out five assists and had six boards vs. Ashland (1/12) ... Ranked fifth on the squad in total points (87), was fifth in made free throws (23) and fourth in assists (35) ... Garnered 64 rebounds in 18 league outings (3.6 rpg) ... **2000-01:** Saw action in 26 games ... Averaged 9.1 minutes per contest ... Scored nine points and had three assists in a win over Lewis (12/5) ... Had a season-best four rebounds and three steals against Northern Michigan (2/3) ... Scored four points against Grand Valley State (2/12) ... Sank her first career three-point basket vs. Missouri-St. Louis (11/18) ... Was 12-of-13 from the charity stripe.

Coach Fisk on DeMartin: "Lucy is a multi-dimensional player who will be difficult for opponents to stop this season. She's improved her overall game and has added confidence."

College: 2001-02: Started 24 games ... Ranked third (14.2 ppg) among the squad's scoring leaders and was second in assists (3.0 apg), fourth in rebounds (4.2 rpg) and second in steals (1.3 spg) ... Named to the GLIAC All-Academic Team and the Verizon Academic All-District IV Second-Team ... Honored as FSU's Defensive MVP and President's Academic Award recipient ... Was fourth among the league's leaders in free throw percentage (.853) and 12th in scoring (14.2 ppg) ... Had 20 double-digit scoring performances, including a personal career-high 30 points at Grand Valley State (2/11) ... Grabbed 11 rebounds and scored 15 points vs. St. Joseph's (12/20) ... **2000-01:** Started 26 games ... Averaged 9.7 points per game ... Scored 21 points in two contests - vs. Hillsdale (2/28) and at Saginaw Valley State (1/25) ... Led the squad in free throw percentage (.815) ... Posted 11 double-figure scoring outings ... Named FSU's Rookie of the Year.

High School: 2000 graduate of Mason High School ... Named to the *Lansing State Journal* All-Area Dream Team ... Four-year letterwinner in basketball and track ... Was a three-year National Honor Society member ... Selected to the academic all-state team in 1998 ... Two-time all-state honorable mention pick and all-league honoree ... Named team MVP and captain ... Led Mason to three district championships and two regional finals ... Averaged 15 points per game as a senior ... Registered 18 points per game as a junior ... Finished in the top 10 of her graduating class ... Played on the Capitol City Express AAU squad, which finished fifth at the national tournament in 1999.
