Coach Fisk on Duesing: "Sarah has developed her game since last season. She's playing with more confidence and finds a way to put the ball in around the basket."

College: 2001-02: Started the final six games ...

Appeared in 23 contests and averaged 1.7 points per game ... Tallied a career-best six points vs. Saginaw Valley State (1/24) ... Grabbed four rebounds in three outings – vs. Northwood (2/9), Saginaw Valley State (1/24) and Southern Indiana (12/30) ... Totaled five points in Ferris' regular-season finale against Michigan Tech (2/23) ... Led the team in field goal percentage (.609; 14-23) ... Scored 27 of her 38 points in league play ... Presented both the team's Rookie-of-the-Year and Most Improved Player Awards ... Recorded four points, three rebounds and two steals in FSU's GLIAC Tournament quarterfinal round loss to Hillsdale (2/28) ... Scored her first career point in the GLIAC/Great Lakes Valley Conference Classic against St. Joseph's (12/20).

High School: A 2001 graduate of Sault Area High School ... Averaged 12.6 points per game as a senior (2000) ... Led the Blue Devils to the state quarterfinals and a 23-3 record in 2000 ... Earned three basketball and four track and field letters ... Was a first-team All-Big North Conference honoree and All-Upper Peninsula selection (2000) ... Registered the state's second-best high jump mark (5-8) during the 2001 season ... Claimed the Upper Peninsula Division I State Championship in the high jump, long jump and 300-meter hurdles (2001).

Personal: Daughter of Paul and Sherry Duesing of Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. ... Born 7/15/83 in Petoskey, Mich. ... Younger sister of all-conference standout Alice Duesing, who plays at Lake Superior State ... Also participates in women's track and field at Ferris State ... Tied for fourth place in the high jump (5-2) at the 2002 GLIAC Outdoor Track and Field Championships ... Majoring in elementary education ... Hobbies include downhill skiing.

Coach Fisk on Horwitz: "Bridget is a force inside and has become a proven scorer in our lineup. She's also done a great job helping our younger post players adjust to the collegiate game."

College: 2001-02: Started 25 games while earning second-team GLIAC North Division and GLIAC All-Academic Team honors ...

Led the team in rebounding (8.8 rpg) and was second in scoring (15.0 ppg) ... Posted 22 double-figure scoring outings and eight double-double (points and rebounds) performances ... Tallied a personal career-high 28 points and 16 rebounds at Wayne State (1/5) ... Finished the season ranked seventh in scoring, third in rebounding and fourth in blocked shots (1.6 bpg) among the GLIAC's leaders ... **2000-01:**

Played in 26 games ... Made 12 starts ... Tallied a season-high 17 points and four blocked shots in a win over Northern Michigan (2/3) ... Had eight double-figure outings ... Scored 11 points against Hillsdale (2/28) ... Totaled 15 points vs. Lewis (12/5) ... Had nine rebounds against Michigan Tech (2/1) ... Recorded the school's 10th-best (17) single-season blocks total ... Played a season-high 32 minutes and tallied eight points vs. Hillsdale (1/11) ... Blocked three shots and had 12 points against Missouri-St. Louis (11/18) ... Had 14 points at Gannon (1/18) ... Earned FSU's Most Improved Player Award.

High School: 2000 graduate of DeKalb High School ... Earned two letters each in cross country, track and basketball ... Coached by Mark Rohm ... Was a two-time first-team Northeast Hoosier Conference and all-area selection ... Chosen as the *Journal Gazette* and 21 Alive Player-of-the-Week ... Averaged 15.1 points per game and 8.1 rebounds per game as a senior ... Led DeKalb to both a conference championship and league tournament title ... Guided her high school squad to a 20-2 mark in her final campaign.
