Coach Fisk on Cenkova: "Lucie is a tough kid who's size will be an asset for a wing player. She's aggressive and has a nice stroke, which makes her a solid threat."

Junior College: Played two seasons at Illinois Central College ... Shot 46.5 percent from the floor and dished out 34 assists during the 2002-03 campaign as ICC won the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Division II National Championship ... Helped lead the Cougars to a 33-3 overall record and their fifth national title in the last 11 years ... Coached by Lorene Ramsey ... Guided team to a 32-3 overall record, a regional championship and third place national tournament finish in 2001-02.

High School: A 2001 graduate of Prague's Gymnasium Pripotocni School ... Attained all-star recognition and served as team captain ... Averaged 16 points and four rebounds per game in her final prep campaign ... Led squad to a national championship while garnering conference and state Most Valuable Player Award honors in 2000 ... Drafted by a professional women's team in the Czech Republic ... Played junior national basketball for the Czech Republic's Second Team and helped lead her city squad to a national title.

Was a two-time (2001-02) all-region honoree and garnered first-team All-Lenawee County Athletic Association accolades in 2002 ... Attained four varsity letters ... Twice (2001-02) received team Most Valuable Player Award kudos ... Served as team co-captain in 2002 ... Guided Ida to a 20-2 mark while averaging 14.7 points per game as a junior (2001) ... Coached by Tim Leonard ... Was a two-time (2001-02) Monroe County Dream Team pick ... Received 2001 Monroe County Player of the Year Runner-up honors ... Also competed in volleyball for two seasons.

Attained first-team 2002 Class A All-State recognition from the *Associated Press*, *Detroit News*, *Detroit Free Press* and the Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan ... Finished fifth in the voting for Michigan's Miss Basketball Award ... Was a member of the *Lansing State Journal's* Dream Team ... Twice (2001-02) earned All-Capital Area Conference (CAC) First-Team honors ... Claimed honorable mention all-area honors as a junior ... Garnered team Most Valuable Player Award accolades twice (2001-02) ... Holds school records for consecutive free throws made in a game (6) and in a season (20) along with most three-point baskets (6) in a contest ... Was a 2002 BCAM Academic All-State pick ... Earned team Best Offensive Player Award kudos ... Served as the Trojans' team captain ... Garnered the school's Rookie of the Year and Hustle Awards as a sophomore ... Coached by Rob Smith ... Received 2002 MHSAA Division II All-State golf accolades ... Four-time All-CAC golf honoree.
