Coach Fisk on Duesing: "Sarah is stronger and more confident this season than she's ever been. She's team-oriented and is tough defensively. In addition, she continues to progress offensively."

College: 2002-03: Played in 26 games while making 15 starts ... GLIAC All-Academic Team selection ... Compiled personal career-highs in points (82) and rebounds (65) ... Netted a career-best 12 points vs. Hillsdale (1/2) ... Scored nine points and had seven rebounds at Northern Michigan (2/20) ... Totaled seven points along with four rebounds vs. Grand Valley State (2/10) ... **2001-02:** Started the final six games ... Appeared in 23 contests and averaged 1.7 points per game ... Tallied a career-best six points vs. Saginaw Valley State (1/24) ... Grabbed four rebounds in three outings – vs. Northwood (2/9), Saginaw Valley State (1/24) and Southern Indiana (12/30) ... Totaled five points in Ferris' regular-season finale against Michigan Tech (2/23) ... Led the team in field goal percentage (.609; 14-23) ... Scored 27 of her 38 points in league play ... Presented both the team's Rookie-of-the-Year and Most Improved Player Awards ... Recorded four points, three rebounds and two steals in FSU's GLIAC Tournament quarterfinal round loss to Hillsdale (2/28).

High School: A 2001 graduate of Sault Area High School ... Averaged 12.6 points per game as a senior (2000) ... Led the Blue Devils to the state quarterfinals and a 23-3 record in 2000 ... Earned three basketball and four track and field letters ... Was a first-team All-Big North Conference honoree and All-Upper Peninsula selection (2000) ... Claimed the Upper Peninsula Division I State Championship in the high jump, long jump and 300-meter hurdles (2001).

Registered a .500 field goal percentage in seven outings ... Grabbed five rebounds vs. Saginaw Valley State (2/15) ... Notched four points and four rebounds vs. Northwood (1/16) ... Placed fifth among team leaders in free throw percentage (.818) ... Played a season-high 21 minutes and recorded four points at Mercyhurst (12/7).

High School: A 2002 graduate of Clare High School ... Led the Pioneers to a school-record 18-4 record and a second consecutive Jack Pine Conference title in 2001 ... Named the 2001 Mt. Pleasant Morning Sun Player of the Year ... Received fifth-team 2001 Detroit Free Press Class C All-State kudos ... Tallied 16.8 points per game to lead the JPC in scoring as a senior ... Became Clare's all-time career rebounding leader (738 rebounds) while averaging 11 boards per game in 2001 ... Was a 2001 Michigan High School Athletic Association Academic All-State honoree ... Three-time team captain and Most Valuable Player Award winner ... Also earned two varsity volleyball letters and four in track and field ... Tallied 15.5 points and 9.8 rebounds per contest as a junior.
