GLIAC/GLVC Classic Up Next For Ferris State

FERRIS AT A GLANCE:

The Ferris State University women's basketball team, which is presently 2-7 overall and 2-2 in Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) action this campaign, will take part in the GLIAC/Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) Classic Thursday and Friday, Dec. 30-31, in Midland, Mich. FSU squares off against Northern Kentucky Thursday (Dec. 30) and then faces Southern Indiana Friday (Dec. 31). Both non-league games begin at 1 p.m. (EST).

LONG ROAD TRIP: Ferris dropped all three of its games on its road trip to the West this past weekend (Dec. 18-21). FSU fell at nationally ninth-ranked North Dakota 114-55 Saturday (Dec. 18) in Grand Forks, N.D., before suffering an 86-74 setback at Minnesota State-Moorhead Sunday (Dec. 19) in Moorhead, Minn. The Bulldogs then lost at NCAA Division I South Dakota State Tuesday (Dec. 21) by a score of 100-48 in Brookings, S.D. Senior forward/center **Bridget Horwitz (Auburn, Ind./DeKalb)** paced the Bulldogs in each game with 12 points at UND and 21 points along with 10 rebounds versus MSUM. She had 13 points and seven rebounds at SDSU.

A LOOK AT THE BULLDOGS: FSU returns three starters and eight letter-winners from last season. The Bulldogs compiled a 21-10 overall record in 2003-04 and reached the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament for only the second time in school history. FSU placed second (14-4) in the GLIAC North Division and advanced to the GLIAC Tournament Championship game during the 2003-04 campaign. The Bulldogs also made their fifth consecutive conference tournament berth and recorded the program's second-ever 20-win campaign last season. Ferris has posted seven-straight winning seasons to date.

HEAD COACH TRACEY FISK: Seventh-year FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 108-68 (.614) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, Fisk guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. Prior to Ferris, Fisk spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at the University of Indianapolis (1997-98). She needs 10 victories to match Pat Dolan's (1977-89) school-record total of 118 wins at Ferris State.

THE BULLDOG TRADITION: The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 31st season of varsity competition, has compiled a 361-393 (.479) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which also claimed GLIAC Tournament runner-up honors in 1999-00, has posted 10 or more victories eight consecutive seasons to date.

JIM WINK ARENA: Ferris has recorded a 41-15 (.732) overall record to date in games at Jim Wink Arena, including a 33-13 (.717) mark in league play. The 2,400-seat facility replaced the Old Jim Wink Arena, which was converted into the current Student Recreation Center after the 1997-98 campaign. FSU won its first 14 games in the facility.

ON THE ROAD: Ferris State is 145-108 (.573) overall since 1995-96 and sports an 84-73 (.535) record in road/neutral site contests during that span. The Bulldogs are 47-36 (.566) overall in road games under head coach **Tracey Fisk**, including a 33-23 (.589) record in GLIAC play.

THE BULLDOG ROSTER: Ferris' 2004-05 roster includes three seniors, three juniors, two sophomores and five freshmen. Five of the 13 players are guards while the remaining eight are frontcourt players. Eleven players

hail from Michigan with one each from Indiana and the Czech Republic.

GLIAC GAMES ON THE AIR: FSU's 2004-05 league games will be carried live by local radio station WBRN-1460 AM. Selected contests can also be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS: The 2003-04 Bulldog squad was honored for having the nation's 17th-highest cumulative grade point average in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll list. The Bulldogs, who placed among the top 25 teams for the fifth consecutive season, compiled a 3.384 grade point average in 2003-04. FSU, which previously compiled the nation's highest gpa (3.534) in 1999-00, also finished 21st (3.313) in 2001-02 and was 20th (3.388) for the 2000-01 academic year. Ferris' 3.604 gpa in 2002-03 placed tied for second.

A LOOK AT NORTHERN KENTUCKY: The Norse maintain a 4-1 series' advantage over FSU entering the GLIAC/GLVC Classic. However, the Bulldogs posted a 70-65 triumph in the most recent meeting (12/29/01) at Big Rapids, Mich. FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** holds a 1-1 career coaching mark versus the Norse. NKU is currently 4-6 overall and 3-3 in the GLVC following Tuesday's (Dec. 21) 67-61 triumph over Fort Valley State in the Sunday Challenger Classic at Highland Heights, Ky. The Norse are guided by 22nd-year head coach Nancy Winstel, who led NKU to the 1999-2000 national championship. NKU was 17-11 overall and a fifth-place tying 12-8 in the GLVC during the 2003-04 campaign. Senior forward Connie Myers leads the Norse in scoring (17.8 ppg) to date. NKU has presently won four of its last five outings this season.

SOUTHERN INDIANA UP CLOSE: The Bulldogs trail USI in the all-time series' 4-1, but posted a 66-56 victory in the last meeting (12/29/02) at Evansville, Ind. The Screaming Eagles, who won the initial four matchups, are currently 7-2 overall and 3-2 in the GLVC this campaign entering Wednesday's (Dec. 22) non-league home game versus North Alabama. The Screaming Eagles, who will face Northwood in the opening day of the GLIAC/GLVC Classic, were 20-10 overall and placed tied for fifth (12-8) in the GLVC a season ago while returning to the NCAA-II Tournament after a one-year hiatus. USI is directed by sixth-year head coach Rick Stein and led in scoring by freshman forward/center Jessica Minnick (14.6 ppg) to date. Southern Indiana, which has currently won its last three outings to date this campaign, was picked to finish fifth in the 2004-05 GLVC Preseason Coaches Poll. Fisk is 1-2 all-time versus the Screaming Eagles.

WE'RE BACK AGAIN: The 2004-05 campaign marks the second consecutive year the Bulldogs have taken part in the GLIAC/GLVC Classic at Midland. Last season (2003-04), Ferris lost to Indianapolis (12/19) 85-77 prior to beating Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (12/20) by a score of 86-71.

FSU PICKED SECOND: Ferris was picked to finish second in the 2004-05 GLIAC North Division Preseason Coaches Poll. The Bulldogs totaled 32 points along with three first-place votes in the balloting conducted by the conference's head coaches. Lake Superior State was selected as the North Division favorite as the Lakers recorded 33 points and four first-place votes. Ashland took the top spot in the South Division with 24 points. Each of the league's 13 head coaches ranked the teams in their respective divisions, but were not allowed to vote for their own team. The first-place team in the North Division received six points while the second-place team earned four points, etc. The first-place squad in the South Division picked up five points, second place took four points, etc.

BETWEEN THE LINES: FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** will make periodic appearances throughout the season on "Between The Lines," a weekly half-hour television show devoted to Ferris State Athletics. The program, which is hosted by Shannon Vesper and produced by FSU's media productions department, airs each Tuesday and Wednesday at 7 p.m. (ET) and 8 p.m. (ET), respectively, on FSU's Cable Channel 7.
