FSU Visits Ashland For GLIAC Tournament Contest This Tuesday

FERRIS AT A GLANCE:

The Ferris State University women's basketball team opens the 2004-05 Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Tournament with a quarterfinal round game this Tuesday (March 1) versus the Ashland Eagles in Ashland, Ohio. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. (EST) in AU's Kates Gymnasium. Ferris is seeded fourth in the South Division while Ashland is first.

FSU FINISHES FOURTH: FSU is currently 11-16 overall and 9-9 in league action. The Bulldogs placed fourth in the GLIAC North Division, but will shift to the South for quarterfinal-round play as five North Division squads made the field. The top three teams from each division and the next two best overall teams garnered playoff berths. Ferris has won eight of its last 16 outings to date this season, including seven of its last 13 contests.

SEVENTH OVERALL BERTH: Ferris has clinched its sixth consecutive and seventh overall GLIAC Tournament berth. FSU has posted a 5-6 (.455) record in six previous tournament bids, including runner-up finishes in 1999-00 and 2003-04. The Bulldogs have reached the semifinal round three different times. Ferris is 1-1 all-time versus Ashland in GLIAC Tournament play.

THE TOURNAMENT FIELD: The other quarterfinal round games include Northern Michigan (#4 seed North) at Lake Superior State (#1 seed North), Michigan Tech (#3 seed North) at Grand Valley State (#2 seed North) along with Hillsdale (#3 seed South) at Gannon (#2 seed South). The HC-GU game will also take place Tuesday at 7 p.m. (EST) with the NMU-LSSU contest slated to begin at 5:30 p.m. (EST) and the MTU-GVSU tilt set to start at 6 p.m. (EST). The quarterfinals will be held on campus sites Tuesday, March 1, with the highest remaining seed selected to host the semifinals/finals Friday and Saturday, March 4-5.

MEDIA COVERAGE: Tuesday's game is tentatively slated to be carried live by local radio station WBRN-1460 AM in Big Rapids and can also be accessed via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. Additional postseason coverage beyond Tuesday's contest will be announced later in the week.

FSU DROPS TWO GAMES: Ferris State concluded conference regular-season action by dropping two games last week in Michigan's Upper Peninsula. The Bulldogs suffered a 75-66 setback Thursday (Feb. 24) at Northern Michigan in Marquette, Mich. FSU then fell to Michigan Tech 60-48 in Saturday's (Feb. 26) regular-season finale at Houghton, Mich. Senior center **Bridget Horwitz (Auburn, Ind./DeKalb)** totaled a game-high 23 points at MTU and had 19 points along with 12 rebounds versus Northern Michigan. Senior guard/forward **Lucie Cenkova (Prague, Czech Republic)** posted a team-best 20 points at NMU while freshman forward/center **Rachel Folcik (Powers/Carney-Nadeau)** added 15 points in the contest.

A LOOK BACK AT LAST YEAR: FSU returned three starters and eight letterwinners from last season entering this season. The Bulldogs compiled a 21-10 overall record in 2003-04 and reached the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament for only the second time in school history. FSU placed second (14-4) in the GLIAC North Division and advanced to the GLIAC Tournament Championship game during the 2003-04 campaign. The Bulldogs also made their fifth consecutive conference tournament berth and recorded the program's second-ever 20-win campaign last sea-

son. Ferris had posted seven-straight winning seasons prior to this year.

HEAD COACH TRACEY FISK: Seventh-year FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 117-77 (.603) career record at Ferris State. She needs one more victory to match Pat Dolan's (1977-89) school-record total of 118 wins at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, Fisk guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. Prior to Ferris, Fisk spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at the University of Indianapolis (1997-98).

THE BULLDOG TRADITION: The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 31st season of varsity competition, has compiled a 370-402 (.479) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which also claimed GLIAC Tournament runner-up honors in 1999-00, has posted 10 or more victories nine consecutive seasons to date.

JIM WINK ARENA: Ferris has recorded a 44-19 (.698) overall record to date in games at Jim Wink Arena, including a 36-17 (.679) mark in league play. The 2,400-seat facility replaced the Old Jim Wink Arena, which was converted into the current Student Recreation Center after the 1997-98 campaign. FSU won its first 14 games in the facility.

ON THE ROAD: Ferris State is 154-117 (.568) overall since 1995-96 and sports a 90-78 (.536) record in road/neutral site contests during that span. The Bulldogs are 51-40 (.567) overall in road games under head coach **Tracey Fisk**, including a 37-26 (.587) record in GLIAC play.

FSU PICKED SECOND: Ferris was picked to finish second in the 2004-05 GLIAC North Division Preseason Coaches Poll. The Bulldogs totaled 32 points along with three first-place votes in the balloting conducted by the conference's head coaches. Lake Superior State was selected as the North Division favorite as the Lakers recorded 33 points and four first-place votes. Ashland took the top spot in the South Division with 24 points. Each of the league's 13 head coaches ranked the teams in their respective divisions, but were not allowed to vote for their team.

THE BULLDOG ROSTER: Ferris' 2004-05 roster includes three seniors, three juniors, two sophomores and five freshmen. Five of the 13 players are guards while the remaining eight are frontcourt players. Eleven players hail from Michigan with one each from Indiana and the Czech Republic.

BETWEEN THE LINES: FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** will make periodic appearances throughout the season on "Between The Lines," a weekly half-hour television show devoted to Ferris State Athletics. The program, which is hosted by Shannon Vesper and produced by FSU's media productions department, airs each Tuesday and Wednesday at 7 p.m. (ET) and 8 p.m. (ET), respectively, on FSU's Cable Channel 7.

BULLDOG BITES

Bridget Horwitz currently ranks fourth on the school's all-time scoring leaders list. She notched her 700th career board at Northern Michigan and scored her 1,400th career point in Saturday's loss at Michigan Tech. Junior guard/forward **Kelly McLaughlin (Clare)** is presently two points shy of registering her 200th career point. **Lucie Cenkova** has scored 10 points or more in six of her last eight games to date. **Bridget Horwitz** has 577 career field goals to date and ranks fourth all-time at Ferris State. She has presently notched 23 double-figure scoring outings this campaign. Her 39 blocked shots to date this season represents the program's fourth-best single season figure in school history. Senior forward **Sarah Duesing's (Sault Ste. Marie/Sault Area)** current .830 (73-88) free throw percentage this season ranks eighth on the school's single-season leaders list. The Bulldogs had only seven players available for their final two regular-season contests in Michigan's Upper Peninsula last week. Ferris has split its last four games to date this campaign.

WE MEET AGAIN: Three of the Bulldogs' last four postseason games will have been against Ashland following this Tuesday's meeting at AU's Kates Gymnasium. FSU defeated the Eagles 86-80 in overtime during the 2003-04 GLIAC Tournament semifinals (3/5/04) at Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., before falling to AU 82-69 in the opening round of last season's NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament (3/12/04) at Quincy, Ill.

MORE BULLDOG BITES: FSU has recorded 10 or more steals 11 times in its last 18 outings this season after having done so only once in its initial nine games this campaign. Eighteen of Ferris' 27 games this campaign have been decided by 10 points or more. The Bulldogs have registered a higher field goal percentage than their opponent in four of their last six games to date this season. Ferris hosted a GLIAC Tournament quarterfinal round game last season and defeated Michigan Tech 72-70 (3/2/04) at FSU's Jim Wink Arena in Big Rapids, Mich.

KEY FSU NOTES: The Bulldogs registered their ninth consecutive 10-win campaign this season. The Bulldogs are averaging 12.1 steals per game in their 11 victories this season compared to only 7.1 steals a contest in 16 defeats. Ferris ranks first among the GLIAC's conference-only leaders in assists (17.5 apg) this campaign. FSU has registered 20 or more assists nine times in its last 13 outings to date this season.

ON CAMPUS AGAIN: The GLIAC Tournament remains on campus sites this season for the third year in a row. Prior to the 2002-03 season, the four previous GLIAC women's tournaments were held at a neutral site location, with the final three taking place at the DeltaPlex in Grand Rapids, Mich.

NCAA REGIONAL INFO: The winner of this season's GLIAC Tournament will receive the league's automatic berth into the NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament slated for March 11-14 at a site to be determined. Eight teams, including six at-large squads, will participate in the regional with the official announcement set to be released Sunday, March 6.

A Look At The Opponent

ASHLAND: AU compiled a school-record 23-8 overall record in 2003-04 after finishing first in the league's South Division with a 12-5 mark. Ashland is currently 19-8 overall this campaign after Saturday's (Feb. 26) 66-64 league home triumph over Hillsdale. AU which is led in scoring by sophomore guard Amber Rall (17.0 ppg), won the GLIAC South Division this campaign with an 11-6 conference mark. The Eagles, who are coached by 10th-year head coach Sue Ramsey, were picked first in the 2004-05 GLIAC South Division Preseason Coaches Poll. Ashland has split its last four games to date this season and is currently 9-3 overall at home this campaign.

SERIES NOTES: The Bulldogs hold an 8-7 series advantage entering Tuesday's meeting. FSU won two of three series' meetings last season, but dropped an 82-69 decision to the Eagles in the NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament (3/12/04) at Quincy, Ill. Ashland defeated Ferris 76-64 in this season's only meeting (12/4/04) at Big Rapids, Mich. Ferris also recorded an 85-81 regular-season win at Ashland (12/6/03) last season and posted an 86-80 overtime triumph in the GLIAC Tourney semifinals (3/12/03) at Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. FSU head coach **Tracey Fisk** presently has a 6-3 career coaching record against the Eagles. The Bulldogs are 4-1 all-time versus the Eagles at Kates Gymnasium.

BULLDOGS AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

The Ferris State women's basketball team has achieved success in more ways than one under head coach **Tracey Fisk**.

The 2003-04 Bulldog squad was honored for having the nation's 17th-highest cumulative grade point average in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll list. It marks the fifth consecutive year Ferris has placed among the nation's top 25 academic teams.

The Bulldogs compiled a 3.384 grade point average in 2003-04. Drury (Mo.) posted a 3.820 team gpa en route to receiving first-place accolades. FSU was one of two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC)-member institutions ranking in the top 25 along with Findlay, which placed second (3.676).

The Bulldogs, who previously compiled the nation's highest gpa (3.534) in 1999-00, also finished 21st (3.313) in 2001-02 and were 20th (3.388) for the 2000-01 academic year. Ferris' 3.604 gpa in 2002-03 placed second and also represented the fifth-best figure among teams from both the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Divisions I, II and III levels along with those representing National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) institutions.

The WBCA Top 25 Team Honor Roll list annually recognizes the nation's highest programs based upon nominations submitted by WBCA-member head coaches.
