Coach Fisk on Horwitz: "Bridget is in the best shape of her career. She's stronger than she's been and we're expecting her to be one of the best scorers and rebounders in FSU history."

College: 2003-04: Missed the entire season due to injury ... 2002-03: Second-Team All-GLIAC North Division and Daktronics All-Great Lakes Region pick ... Led team in rebounding (8.4 rpg) and was second in scoring (16.8 ppg) ... Tallied 22 double-figure scoring outings and nine double-double performances ... Twice received GLIAC North Division Player of the Week accolades ... Scored 35 points at Lewis (12/18) ... Notched 18 points and 18 rebounds vs. Wayne State (1/4) ... 2001-02: Started 25 games while earning second-team GLIAC North Division and GLIAC All-Academic Team honors ... Led the team in rebounding (8.8 rpg) and was second in scoring (15.0 ppg) ... Posted 22 double-figure scoring outings and eight double-double (points and rebounds) performances ... Tallied 28 points and 16 rebounds at Wayne State (1/5) ... Ranked seventh in scoring, third in rebounding and fourth in blocked shots (1.6 bpg) among GLIAC leaders ... 2000-01: Played in 26 games ... Had eight double-figure outings ... Recorded the school's 10th-best (17) single-season blocks total ... Blocked three shots and had 12 points against Missouri-St. Louis (11/18) ... Earned FSU's Most Improved Player Award.

High School: 2000 graduate of DeKalb High School ... Earned two letters each in cross country, track and basketball ... Coached by Mark Rohm ... Was a two-time first-team Northeast Hoosier Conference and all-area selection ... Averaged 15.1 points per game and 8.1 rebounds per game as a senior ... Led DeKalb to both a conference championship and league tournament title ... Guided DHS to a 20-2 mark as a senior.

College: 2003-04: Played in 27 games ... Totaled 47 points and 53 rebounds in 235 minutes of action ... GLIAC All-Academic Team honoree ... Scored five points both at Lake Superior State (2/14) and versus Indianapolis (12/19) ... Dished out 18 assists ... Netted four points, four assists and four rebounds against Gannon (1/22) ... Had four points and three rebounds versus Northern Michigan (2/26) ...

2002-03: Saw action in 22 games ... Tallied a season-high seven points vs. Wisconsin-Parkside (12/14) ... Registered a .500 field goal percentage in seven outings ... Grabbed five rebounds vs. Saginaw Valley State (2/15) ... Placed fifth among team leaders in free throw percentage (.818) ... Played a season-high 21 minutes at Mercyhurst (12/7).

High School: A 2002 graduate of Clare High School ... Led the Pioneers to a school-record 18-4 record and a second consecutive Jack Pine Conference title in 2001 ... Named the 2001 Mt. Pleasant Morning Sun Player of the Year ... Received fifth-team 2001 Detroit Free Press Class C All-State kudos ... Tallied 16.8 points per game to lead the JPC in scoring as a senior ... Became Clare's all-time career rebounding leader (738 rebounds) while averaging 11 boards per game in 2001 ... Was an academic All-State honoree ... Three-time team captain and team MVP ... Earned two varsity volleyball letters and four in track ... Tallied 15.5 points and 9.8 rebounds per game as a junior.
