FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE: The Ferris State University women's basketball team will host Mercyhurst Thursday, Jan. 19, in a 6 p.m. (EST) Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) encounter at FSU's Jim Wink Arena in Big Rapids, Mich. The contest will be the first game of a women's and men's league doubleheader. The men's game starts at approximately 8 p.m. (EST).

MEDIA COVERAGE: Thursday's game will be carried live locally by News Talk 1460 AM (WBRN). Jason DaDay will handle the play-by-play duties for Thursday's coverage. The game is also slated to be webcast at www.ferris.edu/sports.

TICKET INFO: Individual game tickets to FSU regular-season home basketball games can be obtained at the door or by calling the Bulldog Athletics Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888. Adult general admission tickets are \$7. Student tickets are \$5. A family pass with two adult and two youth tickets can be purchased for \$15. Ferris faculty/staff ticket prices are also \$5. FSU students are admitted free of charge by showing their student ID card.

FSU TOPS MARYGROVE: Ferris State opened up a five-game homestand by posting a 82-56 non-conference win over Marygrove Monday (Jan. 9) in Wink Arena. The Bulldogs jumped out to a 41-33 halftime lead on the visitors from Detroit and then outscored the Mustangs 41-23 in the final half to win their fourth consecutive contest this campaign. Senior forward **Kelly McLaughlin (Clare)** notched a personal career-high 14 points and junior guard **Kristin Reinhart (East Lansing)** also totaled 14 points to lead the Bulldogs. Sophomore guard/forward **Sam Johns (Allendale)** netted 12 points and freshman forward/center **Jenna Guay (Escanaba)** had 10 points as four Bulldog players reached double-figure scoring. All 10 Bulldog players who saw action scored and played at least 14 minutes apiece.

BULLDOGS DEFEAT NMU: Ferris State claimed its fifth-straight victory Thursday (Jan. 12) evening as the Bulldogs recorded a 66-53 league triumph over visiting Northern Michigan in Wink Arena. The Bulldogs, who have presently won seven of their last eight outings to date, jumped out to a 34-23 halftime advantage and outscored NMU 32-30 in the final half to account for the 13-point margin. FSU posted a commanding 38-10 edge in points scored in the paint as junior forward **Audrey Thwing (Davison)** led the way with a personal career-high 23 points and 12 rebounds. Sophomore forward/center **Rachel Folcik (Powers/Carney-Nadeau)** added 16 points along with nine rebounds.

BULLDOGS FALL AT THE BUZZER: Ferris State's hopes of knocking off nationally 14th-ranked Lake Superior State were dashed when the final buzzer sounded Saturday (Jan. 14) as the Lakers pulled out a thrilling 82-80 triumph over the Bulldogs in GLIAC action at Wink Arena. LSSU's Shalyn Beauchamp hit an off-balance three-pointer a couple steps beyond the three-point line as the final horn sounded to give the Lakers the victory. Her final shot came after FSU had taken an 80-79 edge on two free throws from **Rachel Folcik** with 4.5 seconds left in regulation. Lake Superior State's win snapped FSU's five-game winning streak. Five Bulldog players reached double-figure scoring. Folcik and **Kristin Reinhart** compiled a team-high 17 points apiece, **Sam Johns** scored 16 points while junior guard **Erin Miller (Niles)** along with **Audrey Thwing** netted 13 points apiece. Thwing added 10 rebounds in a double-double effort for

Ferris State.

The Lakers led 42-40 at halftime and pushed the advantage to 11 points with 12:10 remaining before the Bulldogs rallied. The stretch run was fueled by Reinhart, who scored 13-straight Bulldog points over a three and one-half minute span late in the contest.

LAST SEASON: Ferris State finished the 2004-05 season with an 11-17 overall record. FSU placed fourth in the GLIAC North Division with a 9-9 conference ledger and advanced to the league's postseason tournament for the sixth consecutive year. The Bulldogs also recorded their ninth-straight season with 10 or more victories.

TRACEY BLOODWORTH-FISK: Eighth-year FSU head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 127-84 (.602) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, Fisk guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tourney appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. She spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at Indianapolis (1997-98).

THE BULLDOG TRADITION: The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 32nd season of varsity competition, has compiled a 380-409 (.482) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which also claimed GLIAC Tournament runner-up honors in 1999-00, has posted 10 or more victories nine consecutive seasons to date.

LOOKING BACK AT 2003-04: The Bulldogs compiled a 21-10 overall record in 2003-04 and reached the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament for only the second time in school history. FSU placed second (14-4) in the GLIAC North Division and advanced to the GLIAC Tournament Championship game during the 2003-04 campaign. The Bulldogs also made their fifth consecutive league tournament berth and recorded the program's second-ever 20-win campaign two seasons ago.

THE BULLDOG ROSTER: Ferris' 2005-06 roster includes one senior, three juniors, four sophomores and six freshmen. Five of the 14 players are guards while the remaining nine are frontcourt players. All 12 players on the roster hail from Michigan. Forward **Kelly McLaughlin** is the only senior on the roster.

THE TEAM CAPTAINS: FSU's **Kelly McLaughlin**, **Erin Miller** and **Kristin Reinhart** have been named the Bulldogs' team captains for the 2005-06 campaign.

JIM WINK ARENA: Ferris has recorded a 48-22 (.666) overall record to date in games at Jim Wink Arena, including a 38-19 (.667) mark in league play. The 2,400-seat facility replaced the Old Jim Wink Arena, which was converted into the current Student Recreation Center after the 1997-98 campaign. FSU won its first 14 games in the facility.

ON THE ROAD: Ferris State is 164-124 (.569) overall since 1995-96 and sports a 96-82 (.539) record in road/neutral site contests during that span. The Bulldogs are 55-42 (.567) overall in road games under head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk**, including a 39-27 (.591) record in GLIAC play.

FERRIS SCHOOL RECORDS: Ferris' made 17 three-pointers and 39 attempts beyond the arc versus Lewis (Ill.) in the FSU Holiday Classic (Dec. 21) both surpassed previous school records The Bulldogs also set a new school record with 31 assists at home against Northwood (Dec. 1).

GLIAC GAMES ON THE AIR: FSU's 2005-06 league games will be carried live by local radio station WBRN (News Talk 1460 AM). Selected contests can also be accessed via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. Jason DaDay will handle play-by-play duties for the GLIAC home games while Ferris State Assistant Athletics Communications Director Rob Bentley will be in front of the microphone for all league road contests.

MORE BULLDOG BITES

ON THE INTERNET: Ferris State University Athletics' official web site can be found at www.ferris.edu/sports. The site features information on all of FSU's varsity athletics programs including rosters, statistics, yearbooks and more.

AT THE TOP: Ferris head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** became the school's all-time victory leader with two wins in the Aquinas College Classic (Nov. 18-19). Bloodworth-Fisk, who also ranks as FSU's all-time winningest coach, surpassed Pat Dolan's (1977-89) previous school-record total of 118 wins at FSU. Both of FSU's two all-time NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances have come under Bloodworth-Fisk. She was honored as the GLIAC's 2003-04 Women's Basketball Coach of the Year after guiding the Bulldogs to the program's second-ever 20-win campaign.

NATIONAL STATS: FSU's **Erin Miller** and **Kristin Reinhart** are both found in the latest (Jan. 9) NCAA-II National Statistical leaders. Miller ranks 24th in three-point field goal percentage (.434), 37th in made three-pointers (2.5 pg) along with 41st in scoring (18.0 ppg). Reinhart is 41st overall in assists (5.2 apg). As a team, Ferris ranks 22nd in scoring offense (76.7 ppg).

GLIAC PRESEASON POLL: Ferris State was picked to finish fourth in the 2005-06 GLIAC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason North Division Poll released by the league office. The Bulldogs totaled 23 points in the balloting, which was conducted by the conference's head coaches. A year ago, Ferris State took second place in the conference's preseason coaches poll with 32 points and three first-place votes. Grand Valley State was selected as the North Division favorite as the Lakers recorded 36 points along with six first-place votes. Gannon and Hillsdale tied for the top spot in the South Division with 21 points and three first-place votes apiece. The league's 13 head coaches voted for the division in which they play, but were not allowed to vote for their own team.

PLAYERS TO WATCH: FSU's **Kristin Reinhart** and **Erin Miller** were chosen among the top 10 West Michigan collegiate players to watch this year by the *Grand Rapids Press* in the Nov. 15 edition. The women's rankings honored Reinhart as the second overall selection while Miller came in seventh. Grand Valley State tallied four of the top 10 picks, including the number one honoree in 2004-05 GLIAC Player of the Year Niki Reams. Ferris placed second with two nominations followed by Calvin, Aquinas, Hope and Davenport with one apiece.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS: The Bulldogs have ranked among the nation's top academic programs six consecutive seasons, according to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll list. FSU placed 14th overall in 2004-05 with a 3.432 grade point average. Ferris had the nation's highest gpa in 1999-00 and placed second in 2002-03.

BULLDOG BITES: Last Monday's game against Marygrove was Ferris' final non-conference outing this season FSU has presently won seven of its last nine outings overall this campaign, including five of its last six **Audrey Thwing** netted a career-high 23 points and grabbed 12 rebounds in a double-double effort versus NMU. The 5-11 Thwing has posted a double-double (points & rebounds) in five of her last seven outings to date this campaign **Erin Miller** has reached double-figure scoring in 13 of her last 15 outings this campaign **Rachel Folcik**, who didn't play against Marygrove, has recorded nine consecutive double-digit scoring performances to date this season **Jenna Guay** matched a personal career-high with 10 points against Marygrove. She also had 10 points at Lake Superior State (12/16) earlier this season Five of Ferris State's remaining 11 regular-season games are at home this campaign.

GLIAC HONOREE: FSU's **Erin Miller** was selected as the GLIAC North Division Player of the Week on Dec. 5th for her performance in Ferris' two outings against Northwood and SVSU (Dec. 1 & 3). She is the only FSU women's player to attain league weekly award accolades this season.

FALL RECRUITS: Ferris head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** recently announced the addition of prep guard **Stephanie DeNoyelles (Mt. Pleasant/Sacred Heart)** and prep forward/center **Andrea Clancy (Port Austin/North Huron)**, who both plan to attend and compete in women's basketball at FSU beginning with the 2006-07 academic year. They inked national letters-of-intent with the Bulldogs during the fall signing period. The 5-7 DeNoyelles attained both first-team *Detroit Free Press* and honorable mention *Detroit News* Class D All-State kudos this campaign while Clancy was chosen to the *Associated Press* Class D All-State Girls Basketball Team.

UPCOMING SLATE: Ferris concludes its five-game homestand by squaring off against Gannon Saturday, Jan. 21, in a 1 p.m. (EST) conference home encounter. The Bulldogs will then hit the road for five of their next six outings beginning with a league game Thursday, Jan. 26, at Ashland in Ashland, Ohio.

A LOOK AT THE OPPONENT

MERCYHURST: The Bulldogs maintain a 9-2 series advantage heading into this Thursday's contest and defeated Mercyhurst 66-59 in the last meeting (1/22/05) at Erie, Pa. MC is presently 6-11 overall and 2-5 in the GLIAC as a result of dropping a 83-67 league home decision Saturday (Jan. 14) to Saginaw Valley State. FSU head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** presently has a 6-1 career coaching record against the Lakers. Mercyhurst, which is led in scoring by junior guard/forward Julie Anderson (14.3 ppg), was 8-19 overall in 2004-05 and placed fifth in the GLIAC's South Division with a 4-13 conference record. The Lakers were picked to finish fifth in this season's South Division coaches poll and are guided by second-year head coach Karin Nicholls.
