FSU BASKETBALL AT A GLANCE: The Ferris State women's basketball team will visit Northwood Saturday, Feb. 4, for a 1 p.m. (EST) Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) tilt in NU's Bennett Sports Center at Midland, Mich. The contest will be the first game of a women's and men's league doubleheader.

MEDIA COVERAGE: Saturday's outing will be carried live locally by News Talk 1460 AM (WBRN). Rob Bentley of the FSU Athletics Communications Office will handle the play-by-play duties for Saturday's coverage. The game is also tentatively slated to be webcast at www.ferris.edu/sports.

FSU DEFEATS SVSU AT HOME: Ferris State built an 18-point lead in the opening half and then held on to beat Saginaw Valley State 76-73 in GLIAC action Thursday (Feb. 2) evening in FSU's Jim Wink Arena at Big Rapids, Mich. The Bulldogs led by 18 points with 1:38 to play in the initial period before taking a 46-32 halftime edge. However, the Cardinals rallied back by outscoring FSU 41-30 in the final frame. SVSU led by as many as three points with five minutes left to go before the Bulldogs secured the victory. The Cardinals cut a four-point Ferris State advantage to a single point with 22 seconds left, but the Bulldogs were able to run the clock down to only four seconds when an intentional foul was called on SVSU. FSU junior guard **Erin Miller (Niles)** sealed the win with a pair of free throws. Sophomore forward/center **Rachel Folcik (Powers/Carney-Nadeau)** paced FSU with a personal career-high tying 22 points. Miller added 20 points and junior forward **Audrey Thwing (Davison)** chipped in 17 points along with nine rebounds.

BULLDOGS BEAT FINDLAY: Ferris State posted a decisive 73-48 conference triumph over host Findlay last Saturday (Jan. 28) afternoon in UF's Croy Gymnasium at Findlay, Ohio. The Oilers took an early 9-0 lead before Ferris rallied back and led 38-25 at halftime. FSU then outscored Findlay 35-23 in the final period. Sophomore guard/forward **Sam Johns (Allendale)** paced Ferris State with 14 points. **Rachel Folcik** chipped in 12 points and junior guard **Kristin Reinhart (East Lansing)** added 11 points. Ferris forced 19 turnovers and held the Oilers to a 34.0% (18-53) shooting performance.

FERRIS FALLS AT ASHLAND: Ferris State suffered a 92-59 setback to Ashland in league action last Thursday (Jan. 26) evening in AU's Kates Gymnasium in Ashland, Ohio. The Eagles took a 50-24 halftime lead and then totaled 42 second period points in the decisive victory. **Audrey Thwing** and **Kristin Reinhart** led the Bulldogs with 11 points apiece. Six Ashland players reached double figure scoring. The Bulldogs shot only 31.0% (22-71) from the floor and were two-of-10 (20.0%) beyond the arc. The Eagles made 39-of-74 (52.7%) field goal attempts and connected on nine-of-17 (52.9%) three-point shots. Ferris sank 13-of-18 (72.2%) free throw tries compared to AU's five-of-seven (71.4%) showing at the charity stripe.

LAST SEASON: Ferris State finished the 2004-05 season with an 11-17 overall record. FSU placed fourth in the GLIAC North Division with a 9-9 conference ledger and advanced to the league's postseason tournament for the sixth consecutive year. The Bulldogs also recorded their ninth-straight

season with 10 or more victories.

TRACEY BLOODWORTH-FISK: Eighth-year FSU head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** presently ranks as Ferris' all-time winningest coach with a current 131-85 (.606) career record at Ferris State. A 1996 graduate of Western Michigan, Fisk guided FSU to a 22-7 mark and the school's first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tourney appearance during the 1999-00 campaign. She spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Lake Michigan College (1994-97) and one season at Indianapolis (1997-98).

THE BULLDOG TRADITION: The Ferris State women's basketball program, which is midst its 32nd season of varsity competition, has compiled a 384-410 (.484) all-time mark. The Bulldogs won their only GLIAC crown, advanced to their first NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Tournament and recorded the nation's highest grade point average in 1999-2000. FSU, which also claimed GLIAC Tournament runner-up honors in 1999-00, has posted 10 or more victories nine consecutive seasons to date.

LOOKING BACK AT 2003-04: The Bulldogs compiled a 21-10 overall record in 2003-04 and reached the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament for only the second time in school history. FSU placed second (14-4) in the GLIAC North Division and advanced to the GLIAC Tournament Championship game during the 2003-04 campaign. The Bulldogs also made their fifth consecutive league tournament berth and recorded the program's second-ever 20-win campaign two seasons ago.

THE BULLDOG ROSTER: Ferris' 2005-06 roster includes one senior, three juniors, four sophomores and six freshmen. Five of the 14 players are guards while the remaining nine are frontcourt players. All 12 players on the roster hail from Michigan. Forward **Kelly McLaughlin (Clare)** is the only senior on the roster.

THE TEAM CAPTAINS: FSU's **Kelly McLaughlin**, **Erin Miller** and **Kristin Reinhart** have been named the Bulldogs' team captains for the 2005-06 campaign.

JIM WINK ARENA: Ferris has recorded a 51-22 (.699) overall record to date in games at Jim Wink Arena, including a 41-19 (.683) mark in league play. The 2,400-seat facility replaced the Old Jim Wink Arena, which was converted to the current Student Recreation Center after the 1997-98 campaign. FSU won its first 14 games in the facility.

ON THE ROAD: Ferris State is 168-125 (.573) overall since 1995-96 and sports a 97-83 (.539) record in road/neutral site contests during that span. The Bulldogs are 56-43 (.566) overall in road games under head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk**, including a 40-28 (.588) record in GLIAC play.

FERRIS SCHOOL RECORDS: Ferris' made 17 three-pointers and 39 attempts beyond the arc versus Lewis (Ill.) in the FSU Holiday Classic (Dec. 21) both surpassed previous school records The Bulldogs also set a new school record with 31 assists at home against Northwood (Dec. 1).

GLIAC GAMES ON THE AIR: FSU's 2005-06 league games will be carried live by local radio station WBRN (News Talk 1460 AM). Selected contests can also be accessed via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. Jason DaDay will handle play-by-play duties for the GLIAC home games while Ferris State Assistant Athletics Communications Director Rob Bentley will be in front of the microphone for all league road contests.

GLIAC HONOREE: A Ferris State player received the GLIAC North Division Player of the Week Award for the second consecutive week and third time overall this campaign as **Kristin Reinhart** was honored as last week's (Jan. 23) selection. Reinhart joined **Erin Miller**, who previously was honored Dec. 5, along with **Audrey Thwing**, who was the honoree Jan. 16, as Bulldog players to claim the honor this year. The selection represented the second time Reinhart has picked up the honor in her career as she was also chosen once (12/6/04) last campaign.

MORE BULLDOG BITES

ON THE INTERNET: Ferris State University Athletics' official web site can be found at www.ferris.edu/sports. The site features information on all of FSU's varsity athletics programs including rosters, statistics, yearbooks and more.

AT THE TOP: Ferris head coach **Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk** became the school's all-time victory leader with two wins in the Aquinas College Classic (Nov. 18-19). Bloodworth-Fisk, who also ranks as FSU's all-time winningest coach, surpassed Pat Dolan's (1977-89) previous school-record total of 118 wins at FSU. Both of FSU's two all-time NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances have come under Bloodworth-Fisk. She was honored as the GLIAC's 2003-04 Women's Basketball Coach of the Year after guiding the Bulldogs to the program's second-ever 20-win campaign.

NATIONAL STATS: FSU's **Erin Miller** and **Kristin Reinhart** are both found in the latest (Jan. 30) NCAA-II National Statistical leaders. Miller ranks 19th in three-point field goal percentage (.417) while Reinhart is 29th overall in assists (5.3 apg). As a team, Ferris ranks 22nd in scoring offense (75.5 ppg), 33rd in field goal percentage (.442), 19th in free throw percentage (.748) and 29th in three-point percentage (.362).

GLIAC PRESEASON POLL: Ferris State was picked to finish fourth in the 2005-06 GLIAC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason North Division Poll released by the league office. The Bulldogs totaled 23 points in the balloting, which was conducted by the conference's head coaches. A year ago, Ferris State took second place in the conference's preseason coaches poll with 32 points and three first-place votes. Grand Valley State was selected as the North Division favorite as the Lakers recorded 36 points along with six first-place votes. Gannon and Hillsdale tied for the top spot in the South Division with 21 points and three first-place votes apiece. The league's 13 head coaches voted for the division in which they play, but were not allowed to vote for their own team.

PLAYERS TO WATCH: FSU's **Kristin Reinhart** and **Erin Miller** were chosen among the top 10 West Michigan collegiate players to watch this year by the *Grand Rapids Press* in the Nov. 15 edition. The women's rankings honored Reinhart as the second overall selection while Miller came in seventh. Grand Valley State tallied four of the top 10 picks, including the number one honoree in 2004-05 GLIAC Player of the Year Niki Reams. Ferris placed second with two nominations followed by Calvin, Aquinas, Hope and Davenport with one apiece.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS: The Bulldogs have ranked among the nation's top academic programs six consecutive seasons, according to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll list. FSU placed 14th overall in 2004-05 with a 3.432 grade point average. Ferris had the nation's highest gpa in 1999-00 and placed second in 2002-03.

BULLDOG BITES: The Bulldogs have won 11 of their last 14 games overall this campaign, including nine of their last 11. This season marks the 10th consecutive year the Bulldogs have won 10 or more games in a season The Bulldogs lost to Ashland for the fourth consecutive time last Thursday (Jan. 26). However, FSU then registered its fourth-straight series' triumph over Findlay Saturday (Jan. 28) Four of FSU's six remaining regular-season outings this season are away from home **Rachel Folcik** notched her 500th career point in Thursday's win over Saginaw Valley State. Folcik has scored 10 points or more in 12 out of the last 13 outings she's played to date this campaign **Erin Miller** moved into a tie Thursday evening for second place on the school's all-time chart with 135 career three-point baskets. Miller has reached double-figure scoring in 16 of her last 20 outings this campaign **Kristin Reinhart** currently has 854 career points and is 146 shy of notching her 1,000th career point.

REGIONAL RANKINGS: FSU was listed ninth in this week's (Feb. 1) NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Rankings. The Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) held two of the top three positions in the poll with Lake Superior State the highest ranked GLIAC school at number two. Grand Valley State is fifth, Michigan Tech sixth, Ashland seventh and Hillsdale 10th among the six league schools featured in the rankings. Drury (Mo.) heads the regional poll, which will be used to help determine the eight-team field for the NCAA-II Great Lakes Regional Championships (March 10-13) at the end of the campaign.

UPCOMING STATE: Ferris State makes its annual trek to Michigan's Upper Peninsula next week as the Bulldogs will first square off against Michigan Tech Thursday, Feb. 9, in a 5:30 p.m. (EST) league tilt at Houghton, Mich. FSU then visits Northern Michigan Saturday, Feb. 11, for a 11 a.m. (EST) conference outing in Marquette, Mich.

A LOOK AT SATURDAY'S OPPONENT

NORTHWOOD: The Bulldogs maintain a 38-12 advantage heading into this Saturday's 51st series meeting. FSU has won 20 consecutive series' games and beat NU 102-85 in the last meeting (12/1/05) at Big Rapids, Mich. NU is presently 6-12 overall and 2-9 in GLIAC action this season following last Saturday's (Jan. 28) 71-47 league loss at Michigan Tech. FSU head coach Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk presently has a 15-0 career coaching record against the Timberwolves, who have lost four of their last five games this campaign to date. Northwood, which is led in scoring by senior guard Maureen Elliott (16.8 ppg), was 9-18 overall in 2004-05 and placed sixth (5-13) in the GLIAC's North Division. The Timberwolves, who are guided by second-year head coach Jeff Curtis, were picked to finish fifth in the 2005-06 GLIAC North Division Preseason Coaches Poll. Ferris State is 21-4 (home), 17-7 (road) and 0-1 (neutral) all-time to date versus Northwood. Former Bulldog player Jennifer Brogger (1999-02), who scored 626 points during her FSU career, presently is midst her second season as a NU assistant coach after concluding her collegiate career at Saginaw Valley State. Ferris recorded an 89-64 win (1/26/05) over NU last campaign in Midland.

BULLDOGS AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

The Ferris State women's basketball team has achieved success in more ways than one under eighth-year head coach Tracey Bloodworth-Fisk.

The 2004-05 squad was honored for having the nation's 14th-highest cumulative grade point average in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll. It marks the sixth consecutive year Ferris has placed among the nation's top 25 academic teams.

The Bulldogs compiled a 3.432 grade point average in 2004-05. Drury (Mo.) posted a 3.802 team gpa en route to receiving first-place for the second-straight year. FSU was one of four Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference member institutions ranking in the top 25.

The Bulldogs, who previously compiled the nation's highest gpa (3.534) in 1999-00, also finished 21st (3.313) in 2001-02 and were 20th (3.388) for the 2000-01 academic year. Ferris' 3.604 gpa in 2002-03 placed second and also represented the fifth-best figure among teams from both the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Divisions I, II and III levels along with those representing National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) institutions. FSU was 17th overall (3.384) in 2003-04.

The WBCA Top 25 Team Honor Roll list annually recognizes the nation's highest programs based upon nominations submitted by WBCA-member head coaches.
