Was 31st in free throw % (.842) among NCAA-II statistical leaders ... **2002-03:** Started all 26 contests ... Received the GLIAC's 2002-03 Freshman of the Year Award ... Named FSU's Rookie of the Year ... Ranked as team's third-leading scorer (12.5 ppg) ... Posted 17 double-digit scoring outings ... Registered program's 11th-best single-season steals total (57) ...
