**2006-07/Career highlights and honors:** Amber Rall is the all-time leading scorer in Ashland women's basketball history. She finished her distinguished career with 2,087 points, which makes her only the second player—male or female—in AU history to top the 2,000 point mark. Rall is 25<sup>th</sup> all-time in points scored in Ohio collegiate history, regardless of division or school size. Her 23.4 ppg., places her second in Division II, while her 220 made field goals are third most in the country. She has tallied double digits in points in 23 of 25 games this season, 20 or more points in 19 games, 30 or more points in 5 games, and scored a school-record 42 points against Mercyhurst on Jan. 6, 2007. Rall had a phenomenal scoring streak in the middle of the season in which she tallied 243 points in 9 games (9 straight games of 20+ points), for an average of 27 ppg. She has made 10 or more field goals in 11 games this year. Showing that she is more than just a scoring guard, Rall notched her 336<sup>th</sup> career assist, which places her second all-time in AU history. She leads the GLIAC in ppg. (23.4), is third in three-point percentage (45.8 percent), ninth in minutes played (34.24), tenth in field goal percentage (50.6 percent), and 14<sup>th</sup> in free throw percentage (76.5 percent). This season, Rall has been voted to the GLIAC South Division first team for the third consecutive year. Last year, she helped AU reach the GLIAC Tournament championship game and reach the NCAA Tournament for the second time in three years. The Eagles won the GLIAC South Division in each of Rall's first three seasons at Ashland. She has been named the GLIAC South Division Player of the Week seven different times in her career, including four times this season. She was recognized as the GLIAC Freshman of the Year in 2003-04.
