Compiled 17.5 points, 13 rebounds and three blocked shots a game while helping North Huron claim a district championship with a 17-6 overall record as a junior in 2004 ... Attained team MVP accolades three times along with being named to Huron Daily Tribune All-Star Team ... Competed in both softball and volleyball ... Volleyball team MVP.
