All eyes this season will be on senior split end and Harlon Hill Trophy candidate Clarence Coleman. A first-team All-American and first-team all-GLIAC pick a season ago, Coleman is both the GLIAC and FSU's all-time leader in receptions and receiving yards. He set a single-season school mark with 1,519 yards in receiving and 15 TD's on 97 catches last fall.



Senior outside linebacker Charlie Pierson is one reason why the Bulldog defense should be improved in 2001. Pierson, a 2000 GLIAC Second-Team selection, recorded a team-leading and personal season-high 110 tackles last season.



Tailback Derek Fudge, the 2000 GLIAC "Freshman of the Year", returns for his sophomore campaign after setting the conference freshman rushing record last year with 1,161 yards on 246 carries in 10 league games. His 111.5 rushing yards per outing ranked second best among the GLIAC's rushing leaders.
