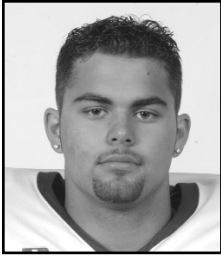


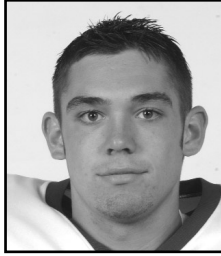

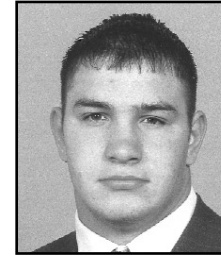

Talented young runner . . . Competing for starting duty at tailback . . . Has a good combination of power and speed . . . Tough runner . . . Muscular, high-energy player who goes at full speed all of the time . . . Elusive-type and changes speeds well . . . Effective receiver with soft and sure hands . . . Shows fine quickness and cutting ability . . . Two-time all-state selection at Allegan High . . . Prepped by Ron Orr . . . Three-time all-conference performer at running back and twice as a defensive back . . . Selected team MVP as a senior and set conference record for yards per carry (13.6 yds.) . . . Rushed for 1,201 yards and 15 TD's during senior year along with 109 tackles and three interceptions . . . All-county and defensive MVP honoree in basketball . . . Team MVP in track . . . Was co-MVP on offense as a senior and recipient of team's Coaches Award on offense during junior campaign . . . Passed for 2,054 yards and 14 TD's with a 55.8% completion percentage (135-242) in final prep season . . . Had six tackles each vs. Northwood (9/29), Grand Valley State (10/6) and at Mercyhurst (10/13) . . . Racked up 12 tackles in 10 outings for 2000 campaign . . . Posted a season-high four tackles vs. Northern Michigan (10/28), including a sack (-6 yds) . . . Notched three stops at Findlay (9/9) . . .
