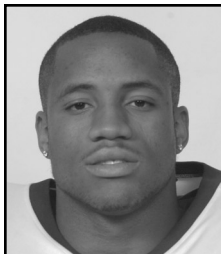

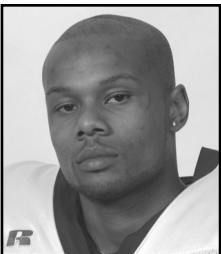

Highly-talented receiver . . . Projected starter . . . Excellent athlete . . . Returns as team's primary punt and kickoff returner . . . Exciting to watch and has "big-play" capabilities . . . Strong and one of squad's fastest runners . . . Has tremendous hands . . . Ranked fifth in both team receptions and receiving yards in 2002 . . . FSU Special Teams Player of the Year . . . Named GLIAC Special Teams Player of the Week following a season-best 104 punt returns yards vs. Saginaw Valley State (10/26), which included an 89-yard TD return . . . Had season-high seven catches for 48 yards at Northwood (10/5) . . . Caught four passes for 71 yards at Findlay (11/2) . . . Associated Press and Detroit Free Press all-state pick in 2001 senior year at Creston High . . . Coached by former FSU quarterback Sparky McEwen . . . A USA Today Dream Team quarterback in final prep campaign . . . Two-time All-City League pick . . . Passed for 2,200 yards and 22 TD's with a 57.6% completion pct. as a senior . . . Compiled 124 tackles (88 solos) with six quarterback sacks as a senior . . . Three-time state shot put qualifier in track and field . . . Had an 18-yard interception return against Ashland (11/9) . . . Notched a pass theft apiece vs. Wayne State (9/28) and Saginaw Valley State (10/26) . . . His 24 tackles was 15th highest in 2001 . . . Posted season-high seven stops vs. Michigan Tech (10/20) . . . Played in all 11 outings . . . FSU's Outstanding Defensive Rookie in 2000 . . . Ranked 12th on the '00 squad with 40 tackles . . .
